FORMAT & SCORING

EIGHT TEAMS COMPOSED OF A MINIMUM OF 3 AND A MAXIMUM OF 5 PLAYERS FROM THE SAME COUNTRY. THE 8 TEAMS SHALL FIRST PLAY IN 2 ROUND ROBIN GROUPS OF 4 TEAMS EACH. EACH TEAM WILL PLAY EACH OTHER IN ITS GROUP TO DETERMINE TOP TEAM. THE TWO TOP TEAMS WILL PLAY IN THE FINAL TO DETERMINE THE WORLD TEAM CHAMPION. THE TEAMS SHALL BE RANKED WITHIN EACH ROUND ROBIN IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: A. THE TEAM WHICH HAS WON THE MOST TIES. B. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE SCORE BETWEEN TWO TEAMS, THE TEAMS WHICH WON THEIR HEAD-TO-HEAD TIE IN THEIR GROUP SHALL BE RANKED HIGHER. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE BETWEEN THREE TEAMS, THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY: THE TEAM WHICH (1) HAS WON THE MOST MATCHES, (2) HAS THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE OF SETS WON, (3) HAS THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE OF GAMES WON. **A TEAM MATCH WILL BE PLAYED OVER ONE OR TWO DAYS AS DETERMINED BY THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE AND SUPERVISOR. THE INTENTION IS TO PLAY EVERY TEAM ON EACH DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT. ALL TEAMS MIGHT / WILL BE REQUIRED TO STAY UNTIL FRIDAY.**
