NEW: Please note there will be no “in person” sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. COVID-19 TESTING					
To Travel:					
Non-resident foreigners arriving from outside Chile must					
1) Fill in the “ Travel Affidavit ” form online up to 48 hours before boarding, providing contact information and health and travel records. This form will display a QR code as a means of verification. It is available at www.c19.cl .					
2) Have health insurance with a minimum coverage of USD\$30,000 that includes coverage for any expenses arising from Covid-19.					
3) Diagnostic tests will be carried out randomly at the entry point to Chile. Confirmed cases shall be isolated according to the general health regulations (declared domicile in the C19 or Sanitary Residence).					
4) It is recommended, although not mandatory , to do a diagnostic covid-19 test before boarding your flight to Chile.					
5) Although no longer mandatory , it is recommended to have your full vaccination course validated by the Chilean authorities at https://mevacuno.gob.cl and obtain a “Mobility Pass” (Pase de Movilidad). The pass allows you to enter the inside lounges in restaurants, cinemas, theatres, and on bus trips, among others.

Please note the following changes regarding <u>new covid-19 protocols</u> at Challenger Tournaments:					
The ATP will no longer test players/support team members at Challenger tournaments unless they become symptomatic. This includes players/PSTs who have not completed a full covid-19 vaccination schedule. Likewise, the requirement for a pre-competition test is no longer required. Please note local/national authorities may still mandate covid-19 testing for entry into a country or competing.					
The number of Player Support Team Members (PST) eligible to obtain an accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players.
