Any player with a FedEx ATP Ranking (singles or doubles) and who is on-site may sign in.

On-Site Alternate Sign-In Deadline (via text message): 30 minutes before the start of qualifying matches

NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. All sign-ins (Doubles, Alternates, Lucky Losers) must be done by phone via text messaging to the Supervisor **Ahmed Abdel-Azim +20 1 006 004 081** to be used for sign-in only. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. If a player would like to preserve eligibility, he must notify the Challenger Supervisor via e-mail ahmed.abdel-azim@atptour.com and request confirmation that his e-mail was received in a timely manner. **No other means of contact than those stated on the detail sheet are accepted.**

COVID-19 TESTING

To Travel: Please note travel requirements are subject to change/updates and you should continue to check the latest updates at German Federal Foreign Office website <https://www.auswaertiges-amt.de/en/visa-service/EinreiseUndAufenthalt> and [BMI](#)

- EU:** No pandemic-related travel restrictions currently apply to travellers entering Germany from member states of the European Union or from Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Iceland. However, under the ordinance governing entry during the coronavirus pandemic (Coronavirus-Einreiseverordnung), travellers are required to complete [digital registration on entry](#), to [present proof of a negative COVID-19 test result](#), proof of vaccination or proof of recovery from COVID-19; and to comply with [the quarantine regulations](#) depending on the [risk status](#) of the country of departure.

From 3 March 2022, every person over the age of 12 is obliged to carry proof of their COVID-19 status when entering Germany. Persons over the age of 12 must therefore have a negative test result or proof of recovery or vaccination when entering Germany. As a rule, COVID-19 test results (antigen or PCR tests) must not be more than 48 hours old at the time of the (planned) entry. However, if entering Germany with a carrier (e.g. an airline), PCR tests may be taken a maximum of 48 hours before the (scheduled) start of the journey (e.g. departure time). But antigen tests must not be taken more than 48 hours before the (scheduled) time of arrival in Germany even if travellers are being transported by a carrier.

- Entry from any **other country** for any purpose (including visits and tourism) is only possible for fully vaccinated people. The traveller must have received the last vaccination dose that is necessary for full vaccination at least 14 days before the date of travel, and the vaccine the person has received must be among those listed on the website of the [Paul Ehrlich Institute](#).
- Travellers who have visited a **high-risk area or area of variant of concern** in the last ten days must register at <https://www.einreiseanmeldung.de/> before arriving in Germany and carry proof of registration with them upon entry. Exemptions to this registration requirement apply in particular to persons who

As countries now gradually relax their covid-19 entry regulations, we advise you to check with your airline whether any documentation may be required before boarding.

Please note the following changes regarding new covid-19 protocols at Challenger Tournaments:

The ATP will no longer test players/support team members at Challenger tournaments unless they become symptomatic. This includes players/PSTs who have not completed a full covid-19 vaccination schedule. Likewise, the requirement for a pre-competition test is no longer required. Please note local/national authorities may still mandate covid-19 testing for entry into a country or competing.

All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players
