SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements for United States: All non-US citizens and non-US residents must present a certificate of full vaccination from a CDC approved vaccine. All travelers regardless of citizenship must provide a negative Covid test (taken 1 day prior to departure) or documentation of recovery from Covid-19 (See Q1) Click [here](#) for complete CDC guidelines.

Testing Procedure: Testing begins on 16 March (practice courts available 17 March) and will be conducted on-site.

Players and their PST(s) must test on arrival (unless exempted-See Q8 for exemptions). Antigen tests will be performed. Only upon receiving a negative antigen result can the player and their PST members receive tournament accreditation and full access to the site. **Thereafter, unvaccinated players and their PST members will be tested every other day (at their own cost) as per the ATP COVID-19 Protocols. ATP will cover the additional testing costs of unvaccinated children (under age 18).**

Greatly reduced on-site Covid-19 protocols aligned with the local health authorities' rules. Removed requirement for mask use indoors except inside physio/doctors' office. Please refer to on-site signage to further information.

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 21 February 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists positioned inside the cut will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Saturday, 6pm local time before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Saturday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

Monday 28 February 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Sunday 20 March 2022 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Hans-Juergen Ochs, T. +49-177-6452220** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Singles Qualifying, Singles Main Draw and Doubles Main Draw withdrawal deadline is on **Sunday 20 March at 6:00pm local time.** Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

IMPORTANT: The Main Draw doubles list will have an entirely advanced protocol of entry. The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on Monday 22 March from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

*The top 13 eligible teams from the final 2021 ATP Doubles Team Rankings shall receive automatic Direct Acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events in the 2022 season (if not included as a Direct Acceptance on their own merit). To qualify for automatic acceptance a team must have competed as a team in 11 ATP Tour or Grand Slam events during the 2021 season. A player can only be eligible on one team. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events a team must have competed together as a team in each week of the 2022 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

HOSPITALITY

There is NO CASH PER DIEM option this year.

Qualifying Comp Hotel: Receive free hospitality beginning Saturday, 19 March for a minimum of 2 nights or through the night of the player's last match.

Main Draw Singles Comp Hotel: Receive free hospitality starting Saturday, 19 March for a minimum of 10 nights or through the night of the player's last match.

Doubles Comp Hotel: Receive free hospitality beginning Sunday, 20 March for a minimum of five nights or through the night of their last match. (NB. Sharing rooms is strongly discouraged due to Covid-19.)

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation: Airport pick-up is provided beginning Thursday, 17 March from Miami International Airport (MIA) ONLY, for all players between 8:00am – Midnight provided 24 hours notice is given. Coaches and PSTs will be picked up only if accompanied by their player. Shuttle transportation will be provided between tournament hotels and the site beginning Thursday, 17 March. All main draw players are eligible to receive private car transfers between the hotels and site. Once you arrive, download WTS app to arrange a private car transfer. Surgical masks required in all tournament vehicles.

In consultation with the ATP and WTA, Miami will be allowing each player to have up to **three (3) PST** members. Singles and Doubles players still competing at the start of the day of singles quarter-final matches will be allowed to bring additional PST members on site (up to 5 total). All PST members are subject to the same testing protocols and guidelines as players.

FAQS

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING THE USA?

A1: All players/PST members who are NOT US citizens or permanent residents **must present a certificate of full vaccination from a CDC approved vaccine**. Click [here](#) for complete CDC guidelines, including acceptable vaccines.

All travelers must present a negative Covid 19 test(taken 1 day prior to departure) or documentation of recovery from Covid-19 . Click [here](#) for complete CDC guidelines.

Visa Requirements - Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and / or USA) for what type of visa is required to enter the USA. The visa duration may be shortened due to COVID-19 control measures.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WILL THERE BE SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE IN MIAMI?

A3: The Miami Open presented by Itau is planning to operate at full capacity,

Q4: FROM WHICH DATE CAN PLAYERS PRACTICE?

A4: **Thursday 17 March**. Once a player or PST member has been cleared by virtue of a negative test (unless exempted) they will be permitted to access the courts for practice, as well as the player areas of the tournament site.

Q5: WHERE CAN TAX/PRIZE MONEY QUERIES BE DIRECTED?

A5: There will not be an on-site Prize Money office this year. Players are responsible for submitting current tax information on the appropriate IRS tax form.

Q6: WHEN WILL TESTING BE ADMINISTERED?

A6: Testing will begin on **Wednesday 16 March** (practice courts available beginning 17 March) on site at Hard Rock Stadium. Everyone will have an antigen test upon arrival on site (unless exempt) and will be able to collect their credential after receiving a negative result.

The tournament will cover arrival testing. Thereafter, any unvaccinated players and PSTs will be responsible for the costs of their testing (every other day). **ATP will cover the additional testing costs of unvaccinated children (under age 18).**

Q7: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN THE USA FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A7: *Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case. CDC Guidelines regarding isolation can be found [here](#).

Positive Test Result

The local public health authority dictates that each individual who tests positive for COVID-19 quarantine in his hotel room for five (5) days after his first symptoms began in addition to being asymptomatic for at least 24 hours. If there were no symptoms isolation ends in five (5) days.

Close Contact

If you are identified as a Close Contact, you will need to self-isolate for five (5) days. Fully vaccinated individuals will not be considered a close contact.

Q8: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE ATP TESTING EXEMPTION PROGRAMME?

- A8:
- Initial exemption from ATP COVID testing is for 90 days from the date of the first positive PCR test. (For example, a player who tested positive for COVID-19 with a valid laboratory PCR test on December 10, 2021, would receive an exemption from ATP testing until March 10, 2022). This exemption can only occur after submitting the test via email to Todd Ellenbecker: Todd.Ellenbecker@ATPTour.com.
 - After 90 days, the individual returns to the ATP testing programme.
 - **Boosted individuals are exempt from testing. The ATP considers a person boosted when he or she has received a booster dose after completing their initial vaccination schedule**
 - This exemption programme is the same for players, player support team members, and tournament staff.
 - Fully vaccinated individuals are required to be tested only upon arrival at the tournament and are exempt from follow up testing unless they develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

Q9: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A9: Since February 2021 ATP has adjusted the List Management procedures for all Tour and Challenger level events due to an increase in government-imposed travel restrictions.

KEY INFORMATION

- Once the acceptance lists are finalised, lists will be frozen until **Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament
- Any player that cannot enter the tournament's country by the Freeze Deadline because of government-issued travel restrictions will be allowed to enter and compete at another event in the same week.
- After the Freeze Deadline, the lists will move as per normal until the withdrawal deadline on **Friday, 10AM, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament

Vacancies before the Freeze Deadline at the Tour and Challenger level will be filled in the following manner:

- The highest-ranked player from the Main Draw (MDS Acceptance List Ranking) withdrawn due to government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- The highest-ranked player from the original main draw alternate list or players from the Tour Qualifying that were also entered on the Main Draw alternate list, withdrawn because of government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- Players may be moved to another tournament's Main Draw if there is a spot available because of withdrawals/unused Special Exempt (SE) positions and if their ranking would have qualified them as a Direct Acceptance on the original entry list
- Players whose ranking would not have made them a Direct Acceptance at other Tournament in the same week will be added to the Main Draw/Qualifying Alternate Lists or the Reserve Acceptance* (RA) positions in the Qualifying.

*Reserve Acceptance (RA) started with tournaments closing for entry in the week of 22 February with three (3) Reserve Acceptances per event.

SPECIAL EXEMPTS

- Special Exempts remain reserved for players that perform well in the previous week. However, any unused Special Exempt spots will be kept available for players that would need to switch from one tournament to another due to travel restrictions
- The criteria described above will fill out unused Special Exempts spots

Q10: WHAT ARE THE RULES REGARDING THE 2022 TOP 12 BONUS POOL?

A10: The Top 12 players in good standing shall be eligible for the bonus pool based upon the ATP Rankings as of the Monday following the Nitto ATP Finals in the current year.

Bonus pool distribution is awarded based on participation at the ATP Masters 1000s and Nitto ATP Finals as follows:

To receive 100%:

- Playing 8 of 8 mandatory Masters 1000 tournaments, plus Finals if qualified, for players with no exemptions
- Playing 7 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with one exemption
- Playing 6 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with two exemptions
- Playing 5 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with three exemptions

To receive 80%:

- Playing 7 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with no exemptions
- Playing 6 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with one exemption
- Playing 5 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with two exemptions
