



SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements for Canada: All foreign nationals must present a certificate of full vaccination from a government approved vaccine. Information regarding accepted vaccines can be found [here](#).

All travelers to Canada must use [ArriveCAN](#) (either App or enter online) to submit their travel information, including vaccination record within 72 hours of arrival to Canada.

- Mandatory [random](#) arrival testing for air travelers qualified as fully vaccinated arriving by air into Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver and Calgary
- Fully vaccinated travelers arriving by land are also subject to mandatory [random](#) arrival testing.
- Travelers who must test will be notified via ArriveCAN App within 15 minutes after entering Canada. **PLEASE SEE EQ1 FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING TESTING**
- If your test result is positive, you must go into isolation and follow the federal requirement to isolate for 10 days from the date of the test result.
- Testing and isolation may be done at tournament hotel.

ATP recommends all players and PSTs to undergo a COVID Antigen Test shortly before beginning travel to Canada to reduce the risk of asymptomatic COVID and possible isolation in Canada.

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 11 July at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES
Monday, 18 July at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN
Friday, 05 August from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Cedric Mourier, +33 623 20 30 12** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 25 July at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Friday 04 August from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

*For each of the remaining four (4) Masters 1000 events, the top 13 eligible teams in the Team Race at the advanced entry deadline for that event, shall receive automatic Direct Acceptance into that Masters 1000 event (if not included as a Direct Acceptance on their own merit). A player can only be eligible on one team. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the final 4 Masters 1000 events, once a team has competed together as a team, they must compete together as a team in each week of the 2022 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS ENTERING CANADA?

A1: All foreign nationals must present a certificate of full vaccination from a government approved vaccine. Information regarding accepted vaccines can be found [here](#).

All travelers to Canada must use [ArriveCAN](#) (either App or enter online) to submit their travel information, including vaccination record **within 72 hours** of arrival to Canada.

- Mandatory **random** arrival testing for air travelers qualified as fully vaccinated arriving by air into Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver and Calgary.
- Fully vaccinated travelers arriving by land are also subject to mandatory **random** arrival testing.
- Travelers who must test will be notified on ArriveCAN App within 15 minutes of arrival into Canada and directed where in the airport to collect the Antigen test. Once collected, they will be given 3 options:
 - 1- Do a test at an authorized drugstore
 - 2- Do the test at a Biron Lab store (Montreal only)
 - 3- Do the test at home or hotel with a nurse supervising the self test online.
- If your test result is positive, you must go into isolation and follow the federal requirement to isolate for 10 days from the date of the test result.
- Isolation may be done at tournament hotel.

Q2: WHAT ARE THE VISA REQUIREMENT FOR CANADA?

A2: Please contact your local embassy to find out if a visa is required. The tournament invitation letter is available through TennisUNO. If you need further information, please contact Richard Quirion, rquirion@tenniscanada.com. Visa-exempt foreign nationals who fly to, or transit through a Canadian airport, need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA). Exception include US citizens and travelers with a valid Canadian visa. Visa-exempt travelers do not need an eTA when entering Canada by land (e.g. Car or bus) or sea (e.g. ship). An eTA can be valid for up to five years or until your passport expires and costs \$7 CAD (approximately \$5 USD). Q3: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A3: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](#).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q4: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN CANADA FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A4: Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

The local public health authority dictates that each individual who tests positive for COVID-19 quarantine in his hotel room for five (5) days after his first symptoms began in addition to being asymptomatic for at least 24 hours. If there were no symptoms isolation ends in five (5) days.

Close Contact

If you are identified as a Close Contact, you will need to self-isolate for five (5) days. Fully vaccinated individuals will not be considered a close contact.

FAQs

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Q5: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A5: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, the unused Reserved Acceptance (RA) spots on the Qualifying Singles lists will be dropped, and all lists will move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q6: WHAT OTHER INFORMATION SHOULD PLAYERS BE AWARE OF REGARDING PRIZE MONEY AND TAXES IN CANADA?

A6: If the player expects to earn no more than CAN\$15,000 in the calendar year, he can apply for a simplified waiver ([R105-S form](#)). For more details, please refer to the R105-S form. We strongly suggest players visit the Prize Money office to receive guidance.

Q7: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A7: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour tournaments only scheduled from the week of 11 July 2022 through the end of 2022 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches seats **on all courts**.
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court.
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phases (no conversations are permitted).
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted.
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent.
- Coaches may not speak to their player when the player leaves the court for any reason.
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions.

Q8: WHAT ARE THE RULES REGARDING THE 2022 TOP 12 BONUS POOL?

A8: The Top 12 players in good standing shall be eligible for the bonus pool based upon the ATP Rankings as of the Monday following the Nitto ATP Finals in the current year. Bonus pool distribution is awarded based on participation at the ATP Masters 1000s and Nitto ATP Finals as follows: To receive 100%: • Playing 8 of 8 mandatory Masters 1000 tournaments, plus Finals if qualified, for players with no exemptions • Playing 7 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with one exemption • Playing 6 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with two exemptions • Playing 5 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with three exemptions To receive 80%: • Playing 7 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with no exemptions • Playing 6 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with one exemption • Playing 5 of 8, plus Finals if qualified, for players with two exemptions For a complete outline, please refer to the ATP Rulebook and/or contact Thomas Schrader (Dir, Player Relations) at Thomas.Schrader@ATPTour.com
