SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements: All travellers must present a **negative COVID-19 PCR test** certificate that is valid for **48 hours or 72 hours (depending on Country of departure)** from the date of the test before departure. Please check with your airline prior to travel for any specific details relevant to your country of departure. There are a list of exempted countries that can obtain their entry visa upon arrival in Dubai. [Check here if you need a visa.](#)

Testing Procedure: Testing starts on Wednesday 16 February. Everyone will need to undergo an Antigen test (RAT) upon arrival at the official hotel. ***NOTE:** Random PCR tests will be conducted on some flights upon arrival at Dubai Airport. For these cases, isolation in the hotel room will be required until the result is received. Turnaround time is 12 hours or less.

- If RAT is positive: PCR test required and must isolate in room until result comes back. Positive case management will come into effect.

- If RAT is negative: No need to isolate and can head on-site to receive accreditation, practice and have full access to the site.

Due to security concerns, players are advised to avoid visiting major landmarks for the duration of the event.

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 24 January 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

Monday 31 January 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Friday 18 February 2022 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Thomas Karlberg, T. +46 70 5523540** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on Friday 18 February 2022 from **12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations should be made 36 hours prior to arrival to avoid incurring charges.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Main Draw: Starting Friday 18 February. Minimum of 6 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 19 February. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. (NB. Sharing rooms is strongly discouraged due to Covid-19)

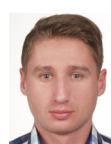

The number of PST members eligible to receive tournament accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player.

Singles and Doubles players still competing at the start of the day of singles quarter-finals matches will be allowed to bring on-site and at the tournament hotel two (2) additional PST members. All PST members are subject to the same PCR testing protocols and guidelines as players.

FAQS

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING THE U.A.E.?

A1: All travellers must present a **negative COVID-19 PCR test** certificate that is valid for **48-72 hours from the date of the test before departure. Please check with your airline prior to travel for any specific details relevant to your country of departure.** Negative COVID-19 certificates must be printed in English or Arabic - hand-written, SMS and digital certificates are not accepted.

All travelers must provide proof of health insurance. A random PCR test will be conducted on some flights upon arrival at Dubai Airport. Once PCR test is conducted, you will need to isolate in your hotel room until a negative PCR test is received.

Passengers who have been in African countries are now permitted to enter Dubai. There are specific requirements that need to be complied with. Please click [here](#) for more details.

All passengers (residents and tourists) arriving in Dubai from the following countries will be required to take another COVID-19 PCR test on arrival at Dubai's airports: Afghanistan, Angola, Argentina, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Brazil, Botswana, Burundi, Cambodia, Chad, Chile, Democratic Republic of Congo, Djibouti, Egypt, Eritrea, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Georgia, Ghana, Guinea, India, Iran, Iraq, Ivory Coast, Jordan, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Lesotho, Liberia, Mauritania, Morocco, Mozambique, Myanmar, Namibia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Philippines, Republic of the Congo, Romania, Rwanda, Russia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Slovakia, Somaliland, Somalia, South Africa, South Sudan, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Tunisia, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Uganda, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member.

A valid visa will be required for some nationalities. Check if you need a visa [HERE](#). If you require a Visa, follow this link to the [Tournament Visa Page](#).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent, players should email TravelSupport@ATPTour.com.

Q3: WILL THERE BE SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE IN DUBAI?

A3: Yes. 100% spectator attendance.

Q4: FROM WHICH DATE CAN PLAYERS PRACTICE?

- A4: **Wednesday 16 February.** Once a player or PST member has been cleared by virtue of a negative test, they will be permitted to access the courts for practice, as well as the players' areas of the tournament site. However, priority will be given to the WTA week for the use of tournament facilities such as practice courts, gym, player dining, stringing services, etc

Q5: WHEN WILL TESTING BE ADMINISTERED

- A5: Testing will begin on **Wednesday 16 February.**

Testing Times - 7:00am - 11:00pm

Testing Location: Mezzanine Level, Jumeirah Creekside Hotel

Test Results - Rapid antigen test results expected within 15 minutes (unless a Government PCR performed at the airport on arrival in which turnaround time is 12 hours or less)

Only upon receiving a negative result, can the player and their PST members receive tournament accreditation and full access to the site. Thereafter, unvaccinated players and their PST members will be antigen tested every two (2) days. Individuals who have had Covid -19 within 90 days are who are on the exemption list, will not be tested unless mandated by Local Government. Random PCR tests will be conducted on some flights upon arrival at Dubai Airport. For these cases, isolation in the hotel room will be required until the result is received within 12 hours or less.

Note: Follow-up tests for unvaccinated individuals will be charged to the individual. Travel/exit tests will also be charged to the individual. Cost of the Antigen test is US \$20 per test and PCR US \$60 per test. Prize money deductions for these costs can be arranged if necessary.

Q6: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN THE U.A.E. FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

- A6: *Please be advised that it is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

If a person tests positive, they must isolate at the official hotel - Jumeirah Creekside - for ten (10) days.

Close Contact

A person who is exposed to a confirmed COVID-19 case, in a close proximity of 1 metre or less, for a period of not less than 15 minutes OR a person who is in direct physical contact with a positive case (e.g. handshake) two days before the positive case showed symptoms or two days before the positive case got the PCR test done or during the 10 days of the illness.

The close contact needs to undergo a seven (7) day quarantine that begins two (2) days before the confirmed COVID-19 positive case undertook a PCR test or two (2) days before the confirmed COVID-19 positive case showed any COVID-19 symptoms.

Q7: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES??

A7: Since February 2021 ATP has adjusted the List Management procedures for all Tour and Challenger level events due to an increase in government-imposed travel restrictions.

KEY INFORMATION

- Once the acceptance lists are finalised, lists will be frozen until **Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament
- Any player that cannot enter the tournament's country by the Freeze Deadline because of government-issued travel restrictions will be allowed to enter and compete at another event in the same week.
- After the Freeze Deadline, the lists will move as per normal until the withdrawal deadline on **Friday, 10AM, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament

Vacancies before the Freeze Deadline at the Tour and Challenger level will be filled in the following manner:

- The highest-ranked player from the Main Draw (MDS Acceptance List Ranking) withdrawn due to government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- The highest-ranked player from the original main draw alternate list or players from the Tour Qualifying that were also entered on the Main Draw alternate list, withdrawn because of government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- Players may be moved to another tournament's Main Draw if there is a spot available because of withdrawals/unused Special Exempt (SE) positions and if their ranking would have qualified them as a Direct Acceptance on the original entry list
- Players whose ranking would not have made them a Direct Acceptance at other Tournament in the same week will be added to the Main Draw/Qualifying Alternate Lists or the Reserve Acceptance* (RA) positions in the Qualifying.

SPECIAL EXEMPTS

- Special Exempts remain reserved for players that perform well in the previous week. However, any unused Special Exempt spots will be kept available for players that would need to switch from one tournament to another due to travel restrictions
- The criteria described above will fill out unused Special Exempts spots.
