



SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements: All travelers must present proof of Covid-19 vaccination, a [Traveler's Health Declaration \(DSV\)](#) completed no more than 24 hours prior to departure AND a negative Covid-19 test, either an RT-PCR performed within 72 hours or an antigen test performed within 24 hours of boarding (**see Q1 for more information**).

Testing Procedure: Testing starts on 9 February.

Players and their PST must test on arrival (unless exempted). Antigen tests will be performed. Only upon receiving a negative antigen result can the player and their PST members receive tournament accreditation and full access to the site.

Thereafter, unvaccinated players and their PST members will be tested every other day (at their own expense) as per ATP COVID-19 Protocols.

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 17 January 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Friday 11 February 2022 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Jorge Mandl, T. +54 9 11 2155 8361** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

Monday 31 January 2022 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The Main Draw doubles list will have an entirely advanced protocol of entry. The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on Friday 11 February from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

The number of PST members eligible to receive tournament accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. Singles and Doubles players still competing at the start of the day of singles quarter-finals matches will be allowed to bring on-site and at the tournament hotel two (2) additional PST members. All PST members are subject to the same testing protocols and guidelines as players.

FAQS

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING BRASIL?

- A1: All travelers must present proof of Covid-19 vaccination, a [Traveler's Health Declaration \(DSV\)](#) completed no more than 24 hours prior to departure AND a negative Covid-19 test, either an RT-PCR performed within 72 hours or an antigen test performed within 24 hours of boarding.
- Brasil accepts all vaccines approved by the Brazilian National Health Surveillance Agency (ANVISA), the World Health Organization (WHO) or the authority of the country in which the traveler was immunized are valid;
 - the application of the last dose or single dose must have occurred at least 14 days before the date of departure.
 - This document must be presented printed or digital in Portuguese, Spanish or English.
 - Document must contain the name of the traveller, the commercial name or name of the vaccine manufacturer, the number(s) of the lot(s)/batch(s) of the applied dose(s) and the date(s) of application of the dose(s);

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

- A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member. These documents will be available to download from [Tennis UNO](#).
- Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WILL THERE BE SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE IN RIO DE JANEIRO?

- A3: The Rio Open presented by Claro is planning to have full capacity.

Q4: FROM WHICH DATE CAN PLAYERS PRACTICE?

- A4: **Thursday 10 February.** Once a player or PST member has been cleared by virtue of a negative test, they will be permitted to access the courts for practice, as well as the players' areas of the tournament site.

Q5: WHEN WILL TESTING BE ADMINISTERED?

A5: Testing will begin on **Wednesday 9 February** at the Sheraton Grand hotel.

Testing Times: 8am - 6pm

Results are expected within TBD. The tournament will cover arrival testing. Thereafter, any unvaccinated players and PSTs will be responsible for the costs of their testing (every other day) per ATP protocols.

Q6: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN BRASIL FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A6: *Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

Individuals who test positive via an antigen test will have a follow up PCR test. Results are expected within 12-24 hours. All positive cases will need to isolate immediately for up to ten (10) days. This can be shortened to five (5) days if the individual has a negative test, and is symptom-free.

Close Contact

Identified close contacts must take a daily antigen test for four(4) days and a PCR test on day five(5). If the results are negative, no isolation is required.

Q7: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE ATP TESTING EXEMPTION PROGRAM TO BE APPLIED IN RIO DE JANEIRO?

- A7:
- Initial exemption from ATP COVID testing is for 90 days from the date of the first positive PCR test. (For example, a player who tested positive for COVID-19 with a valid laboratory PCR test on December 10, 2021, would receive an exemption from ATP testing until March 10, 2022). This exemption can only occur after submitting the test via email to Todd Ellenbecker: Todd.Ellenbecker@ATPTour.com.
 - At that time, the individual returns to the ATP testing programme.
 - This exemption programme is the same for players, player support team members, and tournament staff.
 - **Fully vaccinated individuals are required to be tested only upon arrival at the tournament and are exempt from follow up testing unless they develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19.**

Q8: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A8: Since February 2021 ATP has adjusted the List Management procedures for all Tour and Challenger level events due to an increase in government-imposed travel restrictions.

KEY INFORMATION

- Once the acceptance lists are finalised, lists will be frozen until **Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament
- Any player that cannot enter the tournament's country by the Freeze Deadline because of government-issued travel restrictions will be allowed to enter and compete at another event in the same week.
- After the Freeze Deadline, the lists will move as per normal until the withdrawal deadline on **Friday, 10AM, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament

Vacancies before the Freeze Deadline at the Tour and Challenger level will be filled in the following manner:

- The highest-ranked player from the Main Draw (MDS Acceptance List Ranking) withdrawn due to government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- The highest-ranked player from the original main draw alternate list or players from the Tour Qualifying that were also entered on the Main Draw alternate list, withdrawn because of government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- Players may be moved to another tournament's Main Draw if there is a spot available because of withdrawals/unused Special Exempt (SE) positions and if their ranking would have qualified them as a Direct Acceptance on the original entry list
- Players whose ranking would not have made them a Direct Acceptance at other Tournament in the same week will be added to the Main Draw/Qualifying Alternate Lists or the Reserve Acceptance* (RA) positions in the Qualifying.

***Reserve Acceptance (RA) started with tournaments closing for entry in the week of 22 February with three (3) Reserve Acceptances per event.**

SPECIAL EXEMPTS

- Special Exempts remain reserved for players that perform well in the previous week. However, any unused Special Exempt spots will be kept available for players that would need to switch from one tournament to another due to travel restrictions
- The criteria described above will fill out unused Special Exempts spots
