On-site Doubles entry deadline (via text message): Sat 30 Apr 2022 at 12:00 noon local time. NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. COVID-19 TESTING			
To Travel: Please note travel requirements are subject to change/updates and you should continue to check the latest updates at the French Ministry website and with your Consulate. https://www.interieur.gouv.fr/covid-19-international-travel As of Feb 12 (i) For travelers vaccinated within the meaning of European regulations (i.e. last dose within 9 months or boosted), no more tests will be required on departure. Proof of a complete vaccination schedule becomes sufficient to arrive in France, regardless of the country of origin, as was the case before the distribution of the Omicron variant. Players + PST must complete a sworn statement certifying the absence of Covid-19 symptoms and of any contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19. (ii) For unvaccinated travelers, the obligation to present a negative test to travel to France remains, but the measures on arrival (test, isolation) are lifted when they come from countries on the "green" list, characterized by a moderate circulation of the virus. (iii) When unvaccinated travelers come from a country on the "orange" list, they must continue to present a compelling reason justifying the need for them to come to mainland France and may still be subject to a random test on arrival. From March 14, the French government will suspend the "vaccination pass". It will no longer be necessary to present the pass in any of the places/venues where it was previously required. Vaccinations passes are still needed to enter any medical establishments (hospitals, clinics, etc...). *** PLEASE NOTE THE IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW *** Please note the following changes regarding <u>new covid-19 protocols</u> at Challenger Tournaments: The ATP will no longer test players/support team members at Challenger tournaments unless they become symptomatic. This includes players/PSTs who have not completed a full covid-19 vaccination schedule. Likewise, the requirement for a pre-competition test is no longer required. Please note local/national authorities may still mandate covid-19 testing for entry into a country or competing. <u>The number of Player Support Team Members (PST) eligible to obtain an accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players.</u>
