Main Draw Doubles Advance Entry: **Monday 23 May 2022** at 12:00 noon Eastern Time (Florida, USA) through ATP PlayerZone

Saturday Alternate Sign-In for 24 Qualifying Draw (via text message): **Saturday 28 May 2022** from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. local time
Any player with a FedEx ATP Ranking (singles or doubles) and who is on-site may sign in
Preserved Eligibility Deadline (via email): **Saturday 28 May 2022** from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. local time
On-Site Alternate Sign-In Deadline (via text message): 30 minutes before the start of qualifying matches
On-site Doubles entry deadline (via text message): **Sunday 29 May 2022** at 12:00 noon local time

NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. All sign-ins (Doubles, Alternates, Lucky Losers) must be done by phone via text messaging to the Supervisor **Jorge Mandl +54 9 11 2155 8361** be used for sign-in only. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. If a player would like to preserve eligibility, he must notify the Challenger Supervisor via e-mail jorge.mandl@atptour.com and request confirmation that his e-mail was received in a timely manner. **No other means of contact than those stated on the detail sheet are accepted.**

Please note local/national authorities may still mandate covid-19 testing for entry into a country or competing.
