TRANSPORTATION

Nearest Airport: San Francisco International (SFO), Oakland International (OAK) or Sacramento International (SMF). Airport pick up **NOT** provided. Distance from airport to hotel is 87km, 76km and 89km respectively.

San Francisco Airport

Travel via Bart to the Embarcadero (\$5, 30 minutes), walk 5 minutes to Ferry Building (1 Ferry Building, San Francisco), take Vallejo Ferry (\$10, 55minutes) and then take a ride share to venue or hotel in Fairfield (\$25, 20 minutes).
