



SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements:

Vaccinated travellers no longer have to be tested before departure. Proof of full vaccination suffices to enter France, regardless of the country of departure.

Reminder: Since 1 February 2022, in order for your vaccination schedule to remain recognised as complete, persons aged eighteen or over wishing to enter the French national territory must have received a dose of supplementary messenger RNA vaccine no later than nine (9) months after the injection of the last required dose.

Unvaccinated travellers: see further travel restrictions in [Q.1 FAQs](#).

The ATP will no longer test players/support team members at ATP Tour tournaments unless they become symptomatic. Refer to '[Q.4 FAQs](#)' regarding positive covid cases and close contact management.

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 18 April 2022 at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 25 April 2022 at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Friday 13 May 2022 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Stephane Cretois T. +33 6 10272745** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

Monday 2 May 2022 at 12:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The Main Draw doubles list will have an entirely advanced protocol of entry. The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on Friday 13 May from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in method. To be eligible, alternate teams who did not enter through the online protocol must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING FRANCE?

A1: **Vaccinated travellers** no longer have to be tested before departure. Proof of full vaccination suffices to enter France, regardless of the country of departure.

Reminder: Since 1 February 2022, in order for your vaccination schedule to remain recognised as complete, persons aged eighteen or over wishing to enter the French national territory must have received a dose of supplementary messenger RNA vaccine no later than nine (9) months after the injection of the last required dose.

Unvaccinated travellers are still required to present a negative test result to enter France, but the measures upon arrival (test, isolation) have been lifted when you arrive from a **"green"** country where there is limited circulation of the virus. When unvaccinated travellers arrive from a country on the **"orange"** list, they must continue to present a compelling reason to justify the need to come to metropolitan France and may still have to take a random test upon arrival. Travellers who test positive must self-isolate, in accordance with the recommendations of the public health insurance authority.

During your stay in France, travellers should download the TousAntiCovid application, continue to strictly respect protective measures and physical distancing, wear a face mask and be vigilant and act responsibly if symptoms appear or if they are infected.

If you have travelled through a third country during your return trip to France, but remained in the airport international zone, the rules for the departure country apply.

Foreign visitors must pay for tests in France.

'Green' countries/territories: countries/territories in which no active circulation of the virus is observed and no variants of concern are identified. These are the European Union member States as well as Andorra, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino, Switzerland and the Vatican.

The following countries and territories are also included: Albania, Angola, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Aruba, Azerbaijan, Bahamas, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belize, Benin, Bolivia, Bonaire St. Eustatius and Saba, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Botswana, Bhutan, Brazil, British Virgin Islands, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Canada, Chad, Chile, Colombia, Comoros, Congo, Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Cuba, Curaçao, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Djibouti, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Equatorial Guinea, East Timor, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Faroe Islands, Fiji, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Greenland, Grenada, Guatemala, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Honduras, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Jamaica, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kiribati, Kosovo, Kuwait, Laos, Lebanon, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Maldives, Malawi, Malaysia, Mauritania, Mauritius, Mexico, Moldova, Mongolia, Montenegro, Montserrat, Morocco, Mozambique, Myanmar, Namibia, Nepal, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Niger, Nigeria, Northern Macedonia, Oman, Pakistan, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Puerto Rico, Qatar, Rwanda, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Samoa, Sao Tome and Principe, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Serbia, Seychelles, Solomon Islands, South Africa, South Korea, South Sudan, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Taiwan, Tanzania, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Turks and Caicos Islands, Uganda, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, United States of America, Uruguay, Vanuatu, Venezuela, Vietnam, Virgin Islands, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

'Orange' countries/territories: countries/territories where there is active circulation of the virus in controlled proportions. These are all countries/territories not included in the 'green' list.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with the tournament invitation letter, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either Coach or Physio). These supporting documents are available to download from [Tennis UNO](#). Laissez-Passers will be provided directly from the FFT, and Sworn statements will be available to download from PlayerZone.

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN FRANCE FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A3: *Please be advised that it is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, they must undergo a seven (7) day quarantine at the hotel if fully vaccinated with a booster no older than four (4) months. If the individual tests negative after five (5) days and has no symptoms for two (2) days, they will be released from quarantine.

If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, they must undergo a ten (10) day quarantine at the hotel if not fully vaccinated with a booster no older than four (4) months. If the individual tests negative after seven (7) days and has no symptoms for two (2) days, they will be released from quarantine.

Close Contact

Close Contact case is defined as a person who has not observed Covid-19 health and safety measures (e.g. not worn a mask) for more than 15 minutes while in contact with other subjects.

A close contact case will need to be tested two (2) days after the contact. If the test is positive see the "Positive Test Result" section. Otherwise, strictly enforce barrier measures, including the wearing of masks outdoors and indoors (especially in places with the public).

There are no longer isolation guidelines for contact cases and the testing guidelines are the same regardless of your vaccination status.

Q4: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A4: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, the unused Reserved Acceptance (RA) spots on the Qualifying Singles lists will be dropped, and all lists will move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).
