The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. COVID-19 TESTING				
Click HERE for entry and travel requirements for Canada. • Canada requires <u>all foreign travelers</u> to be <u>fully vaccinated</u>. • <u>All foreign travellers</u> must download the ARRIVECAN app (Android/iOS) and submit their Covid-19 documents through the app <u>a minimum of 72 hours before travel</u>. • If travelling <u>by air</u>, mandatory “at random” testing (selection is random but if chosen to test, it is mandatory) will apply to arrivals through any of these Canada’s <u>four main hubs only</u>: Montréal Pierre-Elliott Trudeau (YUL), Vancouver International (YVR), Calgary International (YYC) and Toronto Pearson International (YYZ) Airports. • If an individual tests positive (see point about random testing above) for Covid-19, he or she <u>will be required to isolate for 10 days</u>. Isolation at the official tournament hotel is acceptable. There is no possibility to shorten the isolation period (e.g., by taking a Covid-19 test before the isolation period ends). All individuals will have to isolate for the full 10 days. • Individuals who have recently recovered from a Covid-19 infection are exempted from mandatory “at random” testing, provided they can provide a positive Covid-19 molecular test result, conducted at least 10 calendar days and no more than 180 calendar days before entering Canada. <u>A positive antigen test is not accepted</u>. ALL PLAYERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS IN ANY OFFICIAL TRANSPORTATION, INCLUDING AIRPORT PICKUP *** PLEASE NOTE THE IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW *** Please note the following changes regarding <u>new covid-19 protocols</u> at Challenger Tournaments: The ATP will no longer test players/support team members at Challenger tournaments unless they become symptomatic. This includes players/PSTs who have not completed a full covid-19 vaccination schedule. Likewise, the requirement for a pre-competition test is no longer required. Please note local/national authorities may still mandate covid-19 testing for entry into a country or competing. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players

TRANSPORTATION

Nearest Airport: Vancouver International Airport (YVR). Airport pick up **NOT** provided. Distance from airport to hotel is 24km. Pick up provided from Waterfront Station 9am to 9pm from Saturday 13 August to Tuesday 16 August.

- Players should take the Canada Line from YVR Airport to Waterfront station (2 zones, approx. 25 minutes) where a host will meet you and escort you to an Official Branded Tournament vehicle for the next scheduled trip to Hollyburn Country Club (approx. 20 minutes). The Canada Line Public Transportation system from the airport cost \$9 (CAD). Fare machines at the train take credit card or local CAD cash.
- Pick Up service from Waterfront station will run 9am to 9pm from Saturday, August 13 to Tuesday, August 16. Players arriving outside of these hours can take a taxi to the hotel/housing or site. Return service for airport drop-offs to Waterfront station will run from Thursday, August 18 to Sunday, August 21.
- Vancouver Operates Uber for players choosing this option. Taxis from Waterfront station to the Hollyburn Country Club cost approximately \$25. Taxis directly from the airport to the hotel or site cost approximately \$55-\$60 CAD.
