



SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry Requirements: Indian visa is required for everyone. Players and PST members can apply online for an e-visa ([click here](#)) or apply at the Consulate General of India in Melbourne. The visa processing time takes 3-5 days. Refer to [Q1 - FAQs](#) for further instructions. **Everyone must present a certificate of full vaccination AND a negative PCR test (72 hours before departure) in order to enter India.** Before travelling, **a self-declaration FORM must be completed** detailing travel history within the last 14 days (includes flight details and hotel stay). Exemption letter available to waive any mandatory quarantine period upon arrival in India.

Testing Procedure: Everyone will need to undergo a RAT (antigen) upon arrival at the official hotel. **NOTE: Random PCR tests may be conducted at the airport by the Government. Refer to Q1 - FAQs for 'At-Risk' countries. After the first RAT on the day of arrival, everyone will need to perform a second RAT on Wednesday February 2.**

- If RAT is positive: PCR test required and must isolate in room until result comes back. Approx. 6 hours wait time for results. Positive case management will come into effect.

- If RAT is negative: No need to isolate and can check into hotel, head on-site to receive accreditation, practice and have full access to the site.

Controlled environment: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, players (and PST members) are required to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel. **Failure to do so will result in players being subject to fines and being withdrawn from the event.**

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 3 January 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

NEW: Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 10 January 2022 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Saturday 29 January from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Sunday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Sunday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to Supervisor, **Andrey Kornilov, T. +998 90 1895113** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

Monday 17 January 2022 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The Main Draw doubles list will have an entirely advanced protocol of entry. The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on Friday 28 January from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

ACCREDITATION

The number of PST members eligible to receive tournament accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. Singles and Doubles players still competing at the start of the day of singles quarter-finals matches will be allowed to bring on-site and at the tournament hotel two (2) additional PST member. All PST members are subject to the same testing protocols and guidelines as players.

FAQS

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING INDIA?

A1: All travellers to India must meet the below requirements:

- Valid passport
- Valid Indian visa issued
- Players and PST members can apply online for an e-visa ([click here](#)). Please check Countries/Nationalities that are eligible for an eVisa
- Players and PST members can also apply for a visa at the Consulate General of India in Melbourne. The visa processing time takes 3-5 days. The Consulate is located at 344 St.Kilda Road, Melbourne, Victoria 3000. Open 9:00am-5:30pm. T: +61 3 9682 5800. [Official website](#)
- Players to apply for a Business Visa- Participation in Exhibitions
- All travellers require a tournament invitation letter and official Ministry visa clearance letters before they can apply for a visa. All supporting visa documents are available for download via [Tennis UNO](#).
- Negative RT-PCR result within 72 hours of arrival
- Individuals must be fully vaccinated and present a certificate of full vaccination
- **Complete a self-declaration [FORM](#)**
- **An official exemption letter has been provided to waive the mandatory quarantine period upon arrival in India. The letter is available for download via [Tennis UNO](#).**
- Please check any other individual travel requirements to India
- **India's at risk countries include: South Africa, Brazil, Botswana, China, Ghana, Mauritius, New Zealand, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Hong Kong, Israel, Congo, Ethiopia, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Nigeria, Tunisia, Zambia and the United Kingdom. All travellers from the above-mentioned nations may need to undergo a PCR-test on arrival at the airport. Testing is available from MyLabs at the airport and is free of charge.**

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with the tournament invitation letter, visa clearance letters, ATP letter of support and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member. All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Players are also required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WILL THERE BE SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE TATA OPEN MAHARASHTRA?

A3: No spectators

Q4: FROM WHICH DATE CAN PLAYERS PRACTICE?

A4: **Wednesday 26 January.** Once a player or PST member has been cleared by virtue of a negative RAT test, they will be permitted to access the courts for practice, as well as the players' areas of the tournament site.

Q5: WHEN WILL TESTING BE ADMINISTERED?

A5: Everyone will need to undergo a RAT (antigen) test on arrival to the official hotel. Results expected within 15 minutes. If the RAT is positive, a PCR test is required and you must isolate in your room until the result comes back. Approx. 6 hours wait time for results. If the RAT is negative, no need to isolate and can check into hotel, head on-site to receive accreditation, practice and have full access to the site.

NOTE: Players will need to undergo their second RAT on Wednesday, February 2.

Players can get a RT-PCR test done on request before their departure at the hotel. A RT-PCR testing van will be stationed at the hotel at all times. Testing will be free of charge.

Q6: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN INDIA FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A6: *Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

Positive cases will be communicated to the Local Municipal Authorities. RT-PCR test is immediately conducted. Asymptomatic patients are isolated in the dedicated isolation floor of the hotel. Pre-defined blood tests taken to check level of infection in blood. Based on PCR report and blood tests, further call to be taken by expert on-site Doctor for need of hospitalisation or only isolation. Respective person stays in isolation until report comes back. Symptomatic positive cases to be hospitalised based on seriousness. Serious cases will be moved to a separate isolation facility ([Jupiter Hospital](#) - one of the best hospitals in the region) for seven (7) days.

Close Contact

If you are a close contact and negative, there is no isolation. Contact tracing will be implemented by the TICO. RAT tests will be performed every day for the next three (3) days. RT-PCR will be required every three (3) days.

Q7: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE ATP TESTING EXEMPTION PROGRAMME TO BE APPLIED IN PUNE?

- A7:
- Non-vaccinated players/PSTs who have recently recovered from Covid will not be allowed to enter and compete in India
 - Everyone must present proof of full vaccination regardless of recent Covid recovery
 - Players will need to undergo a RAT on arrival and their second RAT on February 2

Q8: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A8: Since February 2021 ATP has adjusted the List Management procedures for all Tour and Challenger level events due to an increase in government-imposed travel restrictions.

KEY INFORMATION

- Once the acceptance lists are finalised, lists will be frozen until **Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament
- Any player that cannot enter the tournament's country by the Freeze Deadline because of government-issued travel restrictions will be allowed to enter and compete at another event in the same week.
- After the Freeze Deadline, the lists will move as per normal until the withdrawal deadline on **Friday, 10AM, Eastern Time, USA** the week before the tournament

A8: **Vacancies before the Freeze Deadline at the Tour and Challenger level will be filled in the following manner:**

- The highest-ranked player from the Main Draw (MDS Acceptance List Ranking) withdrawn due to government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- The highest-ranked player from the original main draw alternate list or players from the Tour Qualifying that were also entered on the Main Draw alternate list, withdrawn because of government-imposed travel restrictions introduced after the entry deadline
- Players may be moved to another tournament's Main Draw if there is a spot available because of withdrawals/unused Special Exempt (SE) positions and if their ranking would have qualified them as a Direct Acceptance on the original entry list
- Players whose ranking would not have made them a Direct Acceptance at other Tournament in the same week will be added to the Main Draw/Qualifying Alternate Lists or the Reserve Acceptance* (RA) positions in the Qualifying

SPECIAL EXEMPTS

- Special Exempts remain reserved for players that perform well in the previous week. However, any unused Special Exempt spots will be kept available for players that would need to switch from one tournament to another due to travel restrictions
 - The criteria described above will fill out unused Special Exempts spots
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
