



## SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

**Entry requirements:** Entry to Spain for EU and Non-EU citizens is permitted with one of the following:

- EU Digital Covid Certificate or EU equivalent of Covid-19 vaccination
- Covid-19 recovery certificate - valid for 180 days
- Covid-19 diagnostic test certificate - negative NAAT (PCR) test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival or a negative antigen test taken within 24 hours prior to arrival

**IMPORTANT:** All persons who enter Spain from other countries, who do not have an EU Digital Covid Certificate or EU Equivalent must complete the mandatory Health Control Form ([FORM LINK](#))

The ATP will no longer test players/support team members unless they become symptomatic. Refer to [Q.3 FAQs](#) regarding positive covid cases and close contact management.

# SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

## MAIN DRAW SINGLES

**Monday 23 May 2022 at 12pm EDT** (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

**NEW:** Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10:00 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

## QUALIFYING SINGLES

**Monday 30 May 2022 at 12pm EDT** (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

## QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

**Friday 17 June 2022** from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Thomas Karlberg, T. +46 70 5523540** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

# DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

## DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

**Monday 6 June 2022 at 12:00pm EDT** (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

**IMPORTANT:** The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Friday 17 June from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone, to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

## Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING SPAIN?

A1: **Entry to Spain for EU citizens** is permitted with one of the following:

- EU Digital Covid Certificate or EU equivalent of Covid-19 vaccination
- Covid-19 recovery certificate - if you have previously been infected with the disease, you can obtain a recovery certificate (valid for 180 days) after confirming your positive result with a NAAT test (PCR or similar)
- Covid-19 diagnostic test certificate - by means of a negative NAAT (PCR) test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival in Spain or a negative antigen test taken within 24 hours prior to arrival

**Entry to Spain for Non-EU citizens** is permitted with one of the following:

- Covid-19 vaccination certificate - if more than 270 days have passed since you completed your vaccination schedule, you will need to have a booster dose
- Covid-19 recovery certificate - if you have previously been infected with the disease, you can obtain a recovery certificate provided that more than 11 days have elapsed since the first positive NAAT or rapid antigen test (RAT). Certificate shall be valid for 180 days thereafter

**IMPORTANT:** All persons entering Spain from other countries, including international transits, regardless of their nationality, age or any other consideration, must complete the Health Control Form and obtain their QR to present at boarding and health controls on arrival in Spain. Complete the Health Control Form (**CLICK [HERE TO COMPLETE FORM](#)**) to obtain your Individual QR Code, which will need to be shown at check points.

- If you come from a HIGH RISK country/territory, in order to pass the health controls on arrival in Spain, you will have to present your SpTH QR code together with a certificate of vaccination or recovery, and also a certificate of diagnostic test for active SARS-CoV-2 infection (AIDT), with a negative result. - If you come from a third country, you must first check if you can travel to Spain. Click [HERE](#) for entry requirements into Spain from third countries.

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## Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers player plus one (1) PST member.

All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

### **Q3: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN SPAIN FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?**

A3: \*Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide the protocol to follow on each case.

#### **Positive Test Result**

If a person tests positive, they will be required to quarantine at the tournament hotel for a minimum of ten (10) days. If on day ten 10, this person hasn't had any symptoms for three (3) days, the individual can be released from quarantine.

#### **Close Contact**

Close contacts will not need to quarantine. However, during the 10 days following the last exposure, they must take extreme precautions and reduce social interactions as much as possible, constantly using a mask and maintaining good hand hygiene. In particular, contact with vulnerable persons should be avoided.

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### **Q4: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?**

A4: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, the unused Reserved Acceptance (RA) spots on the Qualifying Singles lists will be dropped, and all lists will move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).
