Any player with a FedEx ATP Ranking (singles or doubles) and who is on-site may sign in. NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. All sign-ins (Doubles, Alternates, Lucky Losers) must be done by phone via text messaging to the Supervisor Stephane Cretois +33 6 10272745 to be used for sign-in only. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. If a player would like to preserve eligibility, he must notify the Challenger Supervisor via e-mail stephane.cretois@atptour.com and request confirmation that his e-mail was received in a timely manner. No other means of contact than those stated on the detail sheet are accepted.					
COVID-19 TESTING					
CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, all credentialed attendees are strongly advised to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel and to follow the WHO, CDC, local authorities' and ATP guidelines to mitigate the risk of contracting Covid-19 when outside of the tournament site.					
The French government has recently passed new legislation on vaccination against covid-19. It requires athletes, aged 16 or older, who compete in a professional sports event, and their support team members, to have completed a full course of vaccination. No access to the site will be permitted without valid proof of vaccination. For Further information and exemptions see Page 3.					
Travel requirements for vaccinated persons below. Please note they are subject to change/updates and you should continue to check the latest updates at the French Ministry website and with your Consulate.					
To Travel: As of Feb 12 (i) For travelers vaccinated within the meaning of European regulations (i.e. last dose within 9 months or boosted), no more tests will be required on departure. Proof of a complete vaccination schedule becomes sufficient to arrive in France, regardless of the country of origin, as was the case before the distribution of the Omicron variant. Players + PST must complete a sworn statement certifying the absence of Covid-19 symptoms and of any contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19. (ii) For unvaccinated travelers, the obligation to present a negative test to travel to France remains, but the measures on arrival (test, isolation) are lifted when they come from countries on the "green" list, characterized by a moderate circulation of the virus. (iii) When unvaccinated travelers come from a country on the "orange" list, they must continue to present a compelling reason justifying the need for them to come to mainland France and may still be subject to a random test on arrival.					
Players and their designated Support Team Members, regardless of their vaccination status , must arrive tested at Challenger tournaments. ATP will accept the following types of tests:					
Negative Antigen or PCR Test taken on Thursday 17th February or later before collecting the tournament credential					
Negative test results (Antigen/RT-PCR) must be submitted through Tennis UNO without delay, but certainly no less than two (2) hours prior to coming on-site to collect accreditation. To create an account with a personal password, follow this link www.tennisuno.com. To upload a test result, log into your Tennis UNO account, go to "My Contacts", click on each person's name and then go to the "Medical Test" section. If you do not have a Tennis UNO account, you must create one.					

Players and support team members are not permitted to use official transportation or access the site to practice without uploading their negative test results, unless otherwise agreed by ATP..

In-competition testing is **not mandatory** for players and PSTs who are fully vaccinated according to the French requirements (page 3). Please submit your vaccination certificate to Todd Ellenbecker at todd.ellenbecker@atptour.com

Currently all players + PST who are not fully vaccinated according to French requirements (see Page 3) must carry proof of a negative Antigen or PCR test of less than 24 hours to access any public place. The tournament will make antigen testing available on site/hotel: schedule to be confirmed.

The number of Player Support Team Members (PST) eligible to obtain an accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. The 2nd PST member credential request must be made before Monday 7th February via Tennis Uno. After that, it will not be possible to receive an extra credential. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: Border restrictions may apply. Before entering these events, all players should check with their local Consular service to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorizations are required.

SUMMARY

- Players and PSTs who fulfil the French vaccination requirements (full vaccination + booster as required) may compete without restrictions.
- Players and PSTs who **do not fulfil** the French vaccination requirements must enter a "controlled environment" if they fall under the **"Exemption Categories"** outlined in the section further below
- Players and PSTs who **do not fulfil** the French vaccination requirements **and are not eligible** for the **"Exemption Categories"** will be unable to compete
- Exemptions only apply to players and two PSTs per player. The PST must be a professional credentialed coach, therapist, etc.

Note: Spouses, partners, friends or equivalent are not eligible for exemptions

"Controlled Environment" covers the following areas:

- Tournament site, including restaurant
- Official transportation
- Official hotel, including restaurant

The following rules must be strictly followed inside the "Controlled Environment":

- Strict 24-hour antigen testing (the timing of tests is essential). **Self-tests are not accepted.**
- Movement is limited to the tournament site and the official hotel. **Any player who competes with an exemption can go for a daily jog but cannot enter a restaurant, supermarket, shopping mall, etc.**

"Exemption Categories" for players and PSTs:

These players and PSTs must enter a controlled environment and submit to daily antigen testing

- Players and PSTs who have completed a Johnson & Johnson vaccine (1 dose) more than 2 months ago but have not received a European Medicines Agency (EMA) recognised messenger Ribonucleic Acid (mRNA) booster dose.
- Players and PSTs who have completed a full vaccination schedule (2 doses) more than 7 months ago (**4 months from 15th February**) but have not received an EMA recognised mRNA booster dose. This includes players and PSTs who have completed a full vaccination schedule with Sputnik, Sinovac and Sinopharm*
- Players who have completed 1 dose of an EMA recognised vaccine and have a confirmed appointment for their second dose within 28 days. **This protocol is valid until 15th February only.**
- Players and PSTs who have recovered from a COVID-19 infection more than 11 days and no more 6 months ago (**4 months from 15th February**).

The vaccination pass becomes active 7 days after the booster dose unless the booster dose was administered a minimum of 7 days within the 7-month validity (4 months from 15th February) time frame of your initial completed vaccination schedule where it becomes active immediately.

E.g. If you have received your booster 3 months and 3 weeks after you completed your initial vaccination schedule, your vaccination pass is active.

(*) Players and PSTs who have completed a full vaccination schedule of Sputnik, Sinovac and Sinopharm, and have received an EMA recognised mRNA booster dose are eligible for a valid vaccination pass.

Additional information for all players and PSTs without an E.U. Digital Covid-19 Certificate and who intend to travel domestically by airplane or public transport:

You are required to travel with an official government-issued Covid-19 vaccination certificate.
