Any player with a FedEx ATP Ranking (singles or doubles) and who is on-site may sign in. NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. All sign-ins (Doubles, Alternates, Lucky Losers) must be done by phone via text messaging to the Supervisor Brian Earley (TEL +1 914 497 1240) to be used for sign-in only. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. If a player would like to preserve eligibility, he must notify the Challenger Supervisor via e-mail Brian.earley@atptour.com and request confirmation that his e-mail was received in a timely manner. No other means of contact than those stated on the detail sheet are accepted.					
COVID-19 TESTING					
CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, all credentialed attendees are strongly advised to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel and to follow the WHO, CDC, local authorities' and ATP guidelines to mitigate the risk of contracting Covid-19 when outside of the tournament site.					
To Travel: All players + PST must have completed a course of vaccination (players should check with their airline for approved vaccines) at least 14 days prior to entry into Bolivia. In addition, all travellers must present a negative PCR test taken up to 72 hours before flying and must have insurance that will cover the cost of any COVID treatment. Note: players will also need proof of vaccination or negative PCR test less than 48 hours old to enter any public space.					
*** PLEASE NOTE THE IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW ***					
Players and their designated Support Team Members must arrive tested at Challenger tournaments. ATP will accept the following types of tests:					
Negative Antigen or PCR Test taken on Thursday 20th January or later before collecting the tournament credential					
Negative test results (Antigen/RT-PCR) must be submitted through Tennis UNO without delay, but certainly no less than two (2) hours prior to coming on-site to collect accreditation. To create an account with a personal password, follow this link www.tennisuno.com . To upload a test result, log into your Tennis UNO account, go to "My Contacts", click on each person's name and then go to the "Medical Test" section. If you do not have a Tennis UNO account, you must create one.					
Players and support team members are not permitted to use official transportation or access the site to practice without uploading their negative test results, unless otherwise agreed by ATP.					
The tournament will organise one (1) in competition PCR testing session on Thursday 27th January between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., and 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Times are subject to change.					
Testing is not mandatory for players and PSTs who are <u>fully vaccinated</u> or <u>recovered from a recent Covid-19 infection</u> (positive Covid-19 test of no fewer than 11 days and no more than 90 days) and are <u>on the ATP Exemption List</u> . Please submit your vaccination certificate to Todd Ellenbecker at todd.ellenbecker@atptour.com .					

Testing is mandatory for:

- All remaining competing players and their designated Support Team Members, if unvaccinated
- All other players who have lost prior to Thursday and who are still using (any of) the official hotel(s) and/or tournament facilities, as well as their designated Support Team Members, if unvaccinated
- All Tournament Support Personnel who are part of the ATP Testing Pool, if unvaccinated

Testing is optional for:

- Vaccinated players and Support Team Members who need testing for onward travel
- Unvaccinated players who have lost prior to Thursday, and their support team members, provided they are no longer using (any of) the official hotel(s) and/or tournament facilities.

The number of Player Support Team Members (PST) eligible to obtain an accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. The 2nd PST member credential request must be made before Monday 10th January via Tennis UNO. After that, it will not be possible to receive an extra credential. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: Border restrictions may apply. Before entering these events, all players should check with their local Consular service to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorizations are required.

FAQS

Q1: DOES THE CURRENT SITUATION CHANGE ANY VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING BOLIVIA?

A1: Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and / or Bolivia) for what [visa is required to enter Bolivia](#). The visa duration may be shortened due to COVID-19 containment measures. Border restrictions may apply. All players should check with their local consular service to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorisations are required. An on-line declaration must also be submitted (in Spanish):

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide Division I & II players with a **Tournament invitation letter** and a **letter of support from ATP** and proof of **travel insurance**. Players can now retrieve all these personalized support letters (including the PST members name) directly from their Tennis UNO account. Check the following explanatory video on how to get them: [VIDEO](#). Players may also be required to travel with appropriate **visa documents**; if you have previously tested positive for COVID-19 to travel with a **copy of your first positive PCR test** (ie: the test that identified you as having COVID-19) and a **copy of a recent Antibody (Serology) Test** showing that you have positive levels of the Antibody (IgG). Immigration authorities may require

travellers to complete a self-declaration or affidavit before arrival. **It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.**

Q3: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS IN PLACE WHEN ENTERING BOLIVIA?

A3: **Please be advised that it is purely informative and subject to change any time without notice. ATP is not responsible if any information is inaccurate.*

All players and PST member MUST:

- have **completed a course of vaccination** (players should check with their airline for approved vaccines) at least 14 days prior to entry into Bolivia
- a **negative PCR test result carried out less than 72 hours** before boarding their flight.
- have **insurance** that will cover the cost of any COVID treatment
- complete the **online registration**

In all cases, the usual travel restrictions apply (visas, valid passport, duration of stay, waivers, etc...).

Also, players must check current regulations (quarantine, RT-PCR testing, travel exemption certificate) to make sure they are eligible to travel to their next destination.

Q4: WHEN SHOULD ALL PLAYERS AND EACH PLAYER'S GUEST, ARRIVE IN SANTA CRUZ?

A4: Hospitality and on-site arrival:

- **For qualifiers, including Wild Cards and Alternates:** from Saturday 22 January through the night of the players' last match. Qualifying starts Sunday 23 January.
- **For Main Draw singles players:** from Saturday 22 January and is available for five (5) nights, or through the night of the players' last match, whichever is later. Main draw singles starts Monday 24 January.
- **For main draw doubles players:** from Sunday 23 January through the night of the players' last match. Main draw doubles starts Tuesday 25 January.

Attention: starting 1st January, players and their designated guests are not allowed to use official transportation or access the site for practice unless they show proof of a negative test.

Controlled environment: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, all credentialed attendees are strongly advised to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel and to follow the WHO, CDC, local authorities' and ATP guidelines to mitigate the risk of contracting Covid-19 when outside of the tournament site.

TOURNAMENT OPERATIONS

Q1: HOW TO REQUEST ACCREDITATIONS, HOTEL RESERVATIONS AND TRANSPORTATION AT THE SANTA CRUZ CHALLENGER?

A1: All players and their guests must request accreditations, hotel reservations and transportation through www.TennisUNO.com. Players need to request on behalf of their guests. You will need to create a new account if you have not already done so. Make sure to fully complete all the profiles first, then you will be able to request accreditations.

Hotel rooms will automatically be reserved for directly accepted MDS and Q players starting Saturday 22nd January and for directly accepted Doubles players starting Sunday 23rd January. Directly accepted MDS and Q players wishing to cancel or amend his automatic reservation must do so by 3pm Thursday prior to the tournament and any Doubles MD player must cancel or amend his reservation by 3pm on the Friday prior to the tournament otherwise **'no shows' will be charged for unoccupied nights. PSTs requiring extra rooms must reserve by Monday 10th January to guarantee a room.** Please, note that e-mailed and onsite accreditation and hotel reservations requests will NOT be accepted. Any hotel booking changes must be made through www.TennisUNO.com as well. To confirm the booking, the tournament may require credit card details to be provided through a secure form.
