NEW: Please note there will be no "in person" sign-ins on-site to respect social distancing rules. COVID-19 TESTING					
CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, all credentialed attendees are strongly advised to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel and to follow the WHO, CDC, local authorities' and ATP guidelines to mitigate the risk of contracting Covid-19 when outside of the tournament site.					
To Travel: Passengers can enter Italy from an EU or Schengen country on presentation of a Covid certificate (Green Pass) confirming full vaccination cycle completed or proof of recovery from Covid or with a negative PCR test taken less than 48 hours before arrival in Italy, or a negative antigen test taken less than 24 hours before arrival. A passenger locator form must be completed. Players should check the status of 'red list' countries before travel to Italy. Note: Non-Vaccinated players will be able to compete on presentation of a 24 hour negative Antigen test. This includes access to the clubhouse and on-site restaurant. The tournament is unable to assist with private accommodation. Players and their designated Support Team Members, regardless of their vaccination status , must arrive tested at Challenger tournaments. ATP will accept the following types of tests:					
Negative Antigen or PCR Test taken on Thursday 10th February or later before collecting the tournament credential					
Negative test results (Antigen/RT-PCR) must be submitted through Tennis UNO without delay, but certainly no less than two (2) hours prior to coming on-site to collect accreditation. To create an account with a personal password, follow this link www.tennisuno.com. To upload a test result, log into your Tennis UNO account, go to "My Contacts", click on each person's name and then go to the "Medical Test" section. If you do not have a Tennis UNO account, you must create one.					
Players and support team members are not permitted to use official transportation or access the site to practice without uploading their negative test results, unless otherwise agreed by ATP.					

Any unvaccinated players + PST must carry proof of a negative Antigen test less than 24 hour old in order to compete. The tournament will make antigen testing available on Thursday 17th February 8am – 12 noon:

In-competition testing is **not mandatory** for players and PSTs who are fully vaccinated or recovered from a recent Covid-19 infection (positive Covid-19 test of no fewer than 11 days and no more than 90 days) and are on the ATP Exemption List. Please submit your vaccination certificate to Todd Ellenbecker at todd.ellenbecker@atptour.com

24 Hour Antigen testing is mandatory for:

- All competing players and their designated Support Team Members, **if unvaccinated**.
- All Tournament Support Personnel who are part of the ATP Testing Pool, **if unvaccinated**.

The number of Player Support Team Members (PST) eligible to obtain an accreditation is strictly limited to two (2) per player. The 2nd PST member credential request must be made before **Monday 31st January via Tennis Uno. After that, it will not be possible to receive an extra credential. All PST members are subject to the same protocols as players.**

PLEASE NOTE: Border restrictions may apply. Before entering these events, all players should check with their local Consular service to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorizations are required.

VISA, TRAVEL, ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Q1: DOES THE CURRENT SITUATION CHANGE ANY VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING ITALY?

A1: Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and/or Italy) for what **visa** is required to enter Italy. The visa duration may be shortened due to COVID-19 containment measures. Border restrictions may apply. All players should check with their local consular service to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorisations are required. Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide players with the **official letter of invitation** from Forlì 4 Challenger, a **letter of support** from ATP, and **proof of travel insurance**. Players can now retrieve all these personalized support letters (including the PST members name) directly from their Tennis UNO account. Check the following explanatory video on how to get them: [VIDEO](#). Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate **visa documents and a waiver**; if you have previously tested positive for COVID-19 to travel with a **copy of your first positive PCR test** (ie: the test that identified you as having COVID-19) and a **copy of a recent Antibody (Serology) Test** showing that you have positive levels of the Antibody (IgG). Immigration authorities may require travellers to complete a self-declaration or affidavit before arrival. **It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.**

Q3: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS IN PLACE WHEN ENTERING ITALY?

A3: **Please be advised that it is purely informative and subject to change any time without notice. ATP is not responsible if any information is inaccurate.*

Currently, entry to Italy is prohibited for people entering from South Africa, Lesotho, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, Eswatini or to those who have been in these countries in the preceding fourteen days (subject to change).

ALL players/PST members arriving from the **EU** or **Schengen Country** MUST travel with:

- a **negative RT-PCR test result** carried out less than **48 hours** or a **negative Antigen test result** carried out less than **24 hours** before entering Italy **along with the certificate of vaccination or recovery proof**. For those who do not have a valid certification of vaccination or recovery, they are required to undergo a 5-day fiduciary isolation in addition to the swab.

Note: Non-Vaccinated players will be able to compete on presentation of a 24 hour negative Antigen test. However, in order to stay at any hotel, take any form of public transport or enter any restaurant or any indoor facility a 'Super Green Pass' showing a full course of vaccination or proof of recovery (less than 6 months) is mandatory. This includes access to the clubhouse and on-site restaurant. The tournament is unable to assist with private accommodation.

In all cases, the usual travel restrictions apply (**visas**, valid passport, duration of stay, etc.). Should you require a visa you are responsible for obtaining that visa.

Also, players must check current regulations (quarantine, RT-PCR testing, travel exemption certificate) to make sure they are eligible to travel to their next destination.

Q4: WHEN SHOULD ALL PLAYERS AND EACH PLAYER'S GUEST, ARRIVE IN FORLI?

A4: Hospitality and on-site arrival:

- **For qualifiers, including Wild Cards and Alternates:** from Saturday 12 February through the night of the players' last match. Qualifying starts Sunday 13 February.

- **For Main Draw singles players:** from Saturday 12 February and is available for five (5) nights, or through the night of the players' last match, whichever is later. Main draw singles start Monday 14 February.

- **For main draw doubles players:** from Sunday 13 February through the night of the players' last match. Main draw doubles start Tuesday 15 February.

Attention: players and their designated guests are not allowed to use official transportation or access the site for practice unless they show proof of a negative test.

Controlled environment: In order to avoid putting yourselves and others at risk, all credentialed attendees are strongly advised to restrict their movements and all meals to either the tournament site, or player hotel and to follow the WHO, CDC, local authorities' and ATP guidelines to mitigate the risk of contracting Covid-19 when outside of the tournament site.

Q1: HOW CAN I COMPLETE THE DAILY HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE?

Q2: DO PLAYERS AND THEIR GUEST NEED TO BE TESTED FOR COVID-19 PRIOR TO TRAVELLING TO THE TOURNAMENT?

A2: Players and their designated Support Team Members that are not on the ATP Exemption list must arrive tested at Challenger tournaments. ATP will accept the following types of tests: a **negative Antigen or RT-PCR Test** dated from **Thursday 10th February** or later. This includes any antigen test taken at a previous week's Challenger or ATP Tour event, provided it is dated from Thursday or later.

Q1: HOW TO REQUEST ACCREDITATIONS AND HOTEL RESERVATIONS AT THE FORLI 4 CHALLENGER?

A1: All players and their designated guests must request accreditation and hotel reservations through www.TennisUNO.com. Players need to make the bookings on behalf of their designated guests. You will need to create a new account if you have not already done so. Make sure to fully complete the profile first, then you will be able to request accreditations and eventually proceed with the hotel reservation.

Hotel rooms will automatically be reserved for directly accepted MDS and Q players starting Saturday 12 February and for directly accepted Doubles players starting Sunday 13 February. Directly accepted MDS and Q players wishing to cancel or amend his automatic reservation must do so by 3pm Thursday prior to the tournament and any Doubles MD player must cancel or amend his reservation by 3pm on the Friday prior to the tournament otherwise 'no shows' will be charged for unoccupied nights. **PSTs requiring extra rooms must reserve by Monday 31 January to guarantee a room.** Please, note that e-mailed and onsite accreditation and hotel reservations requests will NOT be accepted. Any hotel booking changes must be made through www.TennisUNO.com as well. To confirm the booking, the tournament may require credit card details to be provided through a secure form.
