



SECURITY & COVID-19 MEASURES

Entry requirements for the United States: All non-US citizens and non-US residents must present a certificate of full vaccination from a CDC approved vaccine.

NEW: There are new requirements for air passengers 2 years of age and older traveling to the United States from China, Hong Kong, or Macau, and those traveling from Seoul, Toronto, and Vancouver who have been in China, Hong Kong, or Macau in the past 10 days. These passengers, regardless of citizenship or vaccination status, are required to show a negative COVID-19 test result taken no more than 2 days before their flight departs. Those who had COVID-19 in the 90 days before their travel to the United States can instead show documentation of recovery from COVID-19.

SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW
Monday 20 February at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES
Monday, 27 February at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN
Sunday 19 March from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Hans-Juergen Ochs, + 49 1776 452220** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Singles Qualifying, Singles Main Draw and Doubles Main Draw withdrawal deadline is on Sunday 19 March at 6:00pm local time. Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE
Monday 06 March February at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Monday 20 March from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

To qualify for automatic acceptance a team must have competed as a team in 11 ATP Tour or Grand Slam events during the 2022 season. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events a team must have competed together as a team in each week of the 2023 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS ENTERING THE USA?

A1: All players/PST members who are NOT US citizens or permanent residents must present a certificate of full vaccination from a CDC approved vaccine. Click here for complete CDC guidelines, including acceptable vaccines.

There are new requirements for air passengers 2 years of age and older traveling to the United States from China, Hong Kong, or Macau, and those traveling from Seoul, Toronto, and Vancouver who have been in China, Hong Kong, or Macau in the past 10 days. Visa Requirements - Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and / or USA) for what type of visa is required to enter the USA. The visa duration may be shortened due to COVID-19 control measures.

It is the player's responsibility to check any additional and individual travel requirements.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: 2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](#).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com. Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. Q3: WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL IN THE USA FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT AND IDENTIFIED CLOSE CONTACTS?

A3: the *Please be advised that this is purely informative and is subject to change. Local health officials have the authority to decide protocol to follow on each case.

Positive Test Result

The local public health authority dictates that each individual who tests positive for COVID-19 quarantine in his hotel room for five (5) days after his first symptoms began in addition to being asymptomatic for at least 24 hours. If there were no symptoms isolation ends in five (5) days..

Close Contact

No Isolation is required.

Q4: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A4: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour and Challenger Tour tournaments only scheduled through the end of 2023 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches seats on all courts.
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court.
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phases (no conversations are permitted).
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted.
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent.
- Players may approach their coach or engage in conversation with their coach ONLY during the opposing player's Medical Timeout or a Toilet Break/Change of Attire Break
- Coaches may not speak to their player when the player leaves the court for any reason.
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions.

FAQs

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Q6: WHAT ARE THE 2023 RULES REGARDING THE NEW COMMITMENT AND BONUS POOL STRUCTURE FOR THE ATP MASTER 1000 & NITTO ATP FINALS?

A6: NEW COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: top 30 players will be eligible for the bonus pool in 2023 based on total Pepperstone ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals events in 2023.

To receive 100% of the bonus pool a player must play all mandatory ATP Tour Masters 1000 events and the Nitto ATP Finals in which such player is a main draw direct acceptance.

A player's Bonus total will be reduced by 25% for every missed Masters 1000 event. Players may fulfil on-site promotional requirements to recover 12.5% of the 25% reduction per tournament. This may be done a maximum of two times per year, and players may recover a maximum of 200,000 USD. See Bonus' reductions below based on the number of ATP Masters 1000s missed:

OLD COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: under the old structure, players will keep the exemptions they accumulated through 2022. Players will not accumulate further exemptions going forward.

If a player selects the New Commitment Structure, any existing exemption(s) will be removed, and the player moves into the New Commitment Structure.

IMPORTANT: This choice is for bonus compensation only. No new exemptions will be granted moving forward for those electing to keep commitment exemptions earned prior to December 31, 2022. Starting in 2023, each player can only replace Masters 1000 singles main draw results with a better score from an ATP Tour 500 or ATP Tour 250 event, when the replacing score is achieved after the Masters 1000 score that is being replaced. No players will be able to replace zero (0) point ranking penalties for missing Masters 1000 tournaments for any reason.
