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SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 25 March at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Saturday 20 April commitment deadline, before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Saturday commitment deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 1 April at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Sunday, 21 April from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message or mail to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Hans-Jürgen Ochs + 49 1776 452220** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Singles Qualifying, Singles Main Draw and Doubles Main Draw withdrawal deadline is on Sunday 21 April 6:00pm local time. Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday, April 8 at 6pm Madrid time (as normal):

- 16 doubles only teams - advanced entry (doubles only alternates)
- Top 13 Rule applies Monday, April 22 at 12pm Madrid time: 6 singles only teams (or Top 10 singles player + Top 50 doubles player) accepted
- Player entry will go through the doubles online on-site and be considered advanced entry
- Direct acceptance singles players in CH 175s cannot enter at this deadline
- Players can also enter by contacting a member of the Player Relations team Sunday, April 28 at 6pm Madrid time:
- Re-pair/withdrawal deadline for advanced entry teams
- Alternates will be filled by their respective list 3 Opening Sunday, April 28 at 10am Madrid time and closing Sunday, April 28 at 10pm Madrid time:
- 7 singles only teams (or Top 10 singles player + Top 50 doubles player) online on-site entry
- If Direct Acceptance CH 175 players withdraw with still competing in Madrid, they can enter Madrid doubles at this deadline.

DOUBLES

Draw Format:

- 32-team draw, with 16 doubles entry teams and up to 16 singles entry teams
- Doubles entry teams will play the singles entry teams (when possible dependent on entries) in the Round of 32, with a traditional knock out format thereon

The breakdown of entries is:

- 16 advanced doubles only entries
- 6 advanced singles only entries (or Top 10 singles player + Top 50 doubles player)
- 7 online on-site singles only entries (or Top 10 singles player + Top 50 doubles player)
- 3 wild cards

Scheduling:

- The event will take place over five days, beginning on Tuesday (week 2) and finishing on Saturday

On-Court Rules:

- Time between points will be reduced to 15 seconds if a rally is shorter than four shots (1-3 shots = 15 seconds, 4 or more shots = 25 seconds)
- Changeover protocols have changed to increase the speed of play

*The top 13 teams from the final 2023 ATP Doubles Team Rankings shall receive automatic Direct Acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events in the 2024 season (if not included as a Direct Acceptance on their own merit). To qualify for automatic acceptance a team must have competed as a team in 11 ATP Tour or Grand Slam events during the 2023 season. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events a team must have competed together as a team in each week of the 2024 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

Singles Qualifying: Starting Saturday 20 April. Minimum 5 nights.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 20 April. Minimum of 10 nights

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 27 April. Minimum of 5 nights.

Lucky Loser: The top four (4) lucky losers to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top two (2) doubles alternate teams shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

TRANSPORTATION

Nearest airport is Madrid-Barajas Airport (MAD) – located approximately 20 minutes from the site and 15-25 minutes from the tournament hotels.

Airport pick-up available for all players.

Transport service available from Wednesday 17 April. Airport pick-up/drop-off service available 24 hours, **provided that the trip is booked at least 24 hours in advance.**

Q1: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).
All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](#) .

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player’s responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.
To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q2: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A2: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour and Challenger Tour tournaments through the end of 2024 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament’s designated coaches’ seats
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phrases (no conversations are permitted)
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent. Players may approach their coach or engage in conversation with their coach ONLY during the opposing player’s Medical Timeout or a Toilet Break/Change of Attire Break
- Coaches may not speak to their player, when the player leaves the court for any reason
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions

Q3: WHAT ARE THE 2024 RULES REGARDING THE NEW COMMITMENT AND BONUS POOL STRUCTURE FOR THE ATP MASTER 1000 & NITTO ATP FINALS?

A3: NEW COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: top 30 players will be eligible for the bonus pool in 2024 based on total Pepperstone ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals events in 2024. To receive 100% of the bonus pool a player must play all mandatory ATP Tour Masters 1000 events and the Nitto ATP Finals in which such player is a main draw direct acceptance. A player’s Bonus total will be reduced by 25% for every missed Masters 1000 event. Players may fulfil on-site promotional requirements to recover 12.5% of the 25% reduction per tournament. This may be done a maximum of two times per year, and players may recover a maximum of 200,000 USD. See Bonus’ reductions below based on the number of ATP Masters 1000s missed:

OLD COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: under the old structure, players will keep the exemptions they accumulated through 2022. Players will not accumulate further exemptions going forward. If a player selects the New Commitment Structure, any existing exemption(s) will be removed, and the player moves into the New Commitment Structure. IMPORTANT: This choice is for bonus compensation only. No new exemptions will be granted moving forward for those electing to keep commitment exemptions earned prior to December 31, 2023. Starting in 2024, each player can only replace Masters 1000 singles main draw results with a better score from an ATP Tour 500 or ATP Tour 250 event, when the replacing score is achieved after the Masters 1000 score that is being replaced. No players will be able to replace zero (0) point ranking penalties for missing Masters 1000 tournaments for any reason. For a complete rule outline, please refer to the ATP Rulebook, I.
