SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 20 May at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday, 27 May at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday, 14 June from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor or email **Cedric Mourier, +33 623 20 30 12** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 3 June at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Friday 14 June from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

As many players take private accommodation from Queen’s through to Wimbledon, a per diem allowance of £280 will be paid to all players instead of complimentary hotel rooms. Per diems will be paid via bank transfer, alongside player prize money from ATP.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Friday 14 June through the night of the player’s last Qualifying match.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Friday 14 June. Minimum of 6 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 15 June. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. (Sharing rooms is not encouraged).

Doubles Qualifying: Starting Saturday 15 June through the night of the players’ last match. Top LL team to sign-in is covered through end of R1.

Doubles Lucky Loser: The top lucky loser team to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation:

Arrival Transportation: Airport pick up not available. Nearest airport is London Heathrow (LHR).

Taxi fare from Heathrow to Central London can be refunded by Player Services to all Main Draw and Qualifying players upon presentation of a valid journey receipt.

Public Transport: Direct underground line from Heathrow and Central London (Piccadilly Line). Barons Court Tube Station is 200 yards from site.

Airport taxi refunds will be paid to Main Draw and Qualifying players via bank transfer, alongside your prize money from ATP.

Tournament cars will be available for transport from The Queen’s Club and player accommodation beginning Thursday 13 June on first come, first served basis and is strictly reserved for players and PSTs only.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS ENTERING THE UNITED KINGDOM?

A1: There are no Covid-19 requirements or restrictions to enter the UK.

Visa Requirements - Players should check with their local consular service for what type of visa is required to enter the UK.

It is the player's responsibility to check any additional and individual travel requirements.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](https://tennisuno.com).

Individuals from Russia and Belarus intending to enter this event are required to sign a neutrality declaration form. Once the declaration form has been signed, it will remain valid until the completion of the last event in which the individual is involved.

Note: The declaration form must be signed before the entry deadline of the first UK event you intend to play. It is the responsibility of each player to ensure that they have signed the declaration form before the tournament entry deadline. Please note that a separate neutrality declaration form must be signed for The Championships, Wimbledon.

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q3. WHAT OTHER INFORMATION SHOULD PLAYERS BE AWARE OF REGARDING PRIZE MONEY AND TAXES IN THE UK?

A3. Withholding Tax at UK LTA Events:

Prize money issued by the LTA events is subject to a withholding tax under UK Tax Authority. Under the revised "Reduced Rate Tax Withholding Application" the amount earned by any non-UK resident player before tax is £12,570 from 6 April 2024 to 5 April 2025. Once a non-UK resident player's earnings exceed this amount, all prize money earned from LTA events will be subject to a 20% withholding tax deduction.

When tax is deducted on-site Player Services will complete a FEU2 form showing details of prize money earned and tax withheld. A copy of FEU2 form will be provided to players during event and players should retain this for their tax agent / manager. **A duplicate copy cannot be issued.** The LTA will be responsible for paying the tax withheld over to the UK Tax Authority.

Q4: WHAT ARE THE LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A4: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, lists will be dropped for withdrawals and move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q5: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A5: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour and Challenger tournaments scheduled through the end of 2024 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches seats on all courts.
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court.
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phases (no conversations are permitted).
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted.
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent.
- Players may approach their coach or engage in conversation with their coach ONLY during the opposing player's Medical Timeout or a Toilet Break/Change of Attire Break
- Coaches may not speak to their player when the player leaves the court for any reason.
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions.

FAQs

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Q6: HOW DOES THE 2024 ATP 500 BONUS POOL WORK?

A6: Total compensation of \$1,340,000 will be distributed to the Top 5 players with the most PIF ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour 500* category in 2024. Players must be in good standing and meet platinum benefits eligibility and commitment requirements.

- Rank 1: \$615,000
- Rank 2: \$310,000
- Rank 3: \$205,000
- Rank 4: \$130,000
- Rank 5: \$80,000

*For the avoidance of doubt, points from Monte Carlo Masters 1000 tournament will not be included I the ATP Tour 500 bonus pool point calculation.
