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SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 13 May at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday, 20 May at 12pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday 7 June from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor; Hans-Jürgen Ochs; +49 (177) 645 2220 (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 27 May at 12:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Friday 7 June from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Friday 7 June through the night of the player’s last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 8 June Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 8 June. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another main draw doubles player.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](https://tennisuno.com).

Division I and II player members have been sent a Digital ID, which can provide proof of status as a professional player. Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID. If you need this resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q2: WHAT ARE THE LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A2: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, lists will be dropped for withdrawals and move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q3: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A3: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour tournaments through the end of 2024 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches seats on all courts.
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court.
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phases (no conversations are permitted).
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted.
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent.
- Players may approach their coach or engage in conversation with their coach ONLY during the opposing player's Medical Timeout or a Toilet Break/Change of Attire Break.
- Coaches may not speak to their player when the player leaves the court for any reason.
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions.

Q4: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A4: Late Entries

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list. Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
