MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 19 August 2024 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 26 August 2024 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Monday 16 September 2024 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Tuesday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Tuesday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by phone via text message to the Supervisor, **Rogério Santos, T. +351 92 9123967** (number to be used for sign-in only), email (Rogério.Santos@ATPTour.com) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 13 September from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Monday 16 September through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Monday 16 September. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Monday 16 September. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING CHINA?

A1: **Everyone requires a visa for China.** Click [HERE](#) to submit your visa invitation letter request.

Once the invitation letter is received, please complete and submit the application form via the Chinese Visa Application Center and apply for the China "M" Business Visa - appropriate for participation in a professional sports event as an athlete, coach, team physician or other support personnel.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio).

All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#). It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A3: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, all lists will move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q4: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A4: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour tournaments through the end of 2024 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches' seats on all courts
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phrases (no conversations are permitted)
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent
- Coaches may not speak to their player, when the player leaves the court for any reason
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions

Q5: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A5: Late Entries

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN HANGZHOU (TUESDAY FINAL) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT

- ATP Tour still competing deadline (**week of 23 September**): Beijing/Tokyo

• **Singles players directedly accepted into Tokyo Q:** Players still competing in Hangzhou on **Monday 23 September** will be withdrawn automatically from Tokyo Q Singles.

• **Singles players directedly accepted into Beijing Q:** Players still competing in Hangzhou on **Tuesday 24 September** will be withdrawn automatically from Beijing Q Singles.

- Challenger Tour still competing deadline (**week of 25 September**): Antofagasta/**Nonthaburi 4**/**Orleans**/Lisbon/Charleston, SC

• **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger main draw (Antofagasta, Lisbon and Charleston) the week of 23 September and are still competing in Hangzhou on **Saturday 21 September** by 9:00pm local time (Challenger), will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.

• **Exceptions: Nonthaburi 4 (TUES Start) and Orleans (IH).** Players directly accepted into Nonthaburi 4 and Orleans main draw will be allowed to compete that week. If players accepted in Orleans withdraw after **Saturday 21 September** by 9:00pm local time (Challenger), or if players accepted in Nonthaburi 4 withdraw after **Sunday 22 September** 9:00pm local time (Challenger), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Hangzhou has a Tuesday final, which allows players to finish the tournament and still make it to the two Challengers. Nonthaburi 4 has a Tuesday start, with first rounds Tues/Wed and Orleans is an indoor hard event with first rounds Mon-Wed.

• **Doubles:** Player/Team directly accepted into a Challenger doubles main draw the week of 23 September or sign-in on-site via the Supervisor on Sunday 22 September 12 noon local time (Antofagasta, Lisbon, Charleston and Orleans) or Monday 23 September 12 noon local time (Nonthaburi 4), can compete that week. If they withdraw after the on-site sign-in deadline Sunday (Antofagasta, Lisbon, Charleston, and Orleans) and Monday (Nonthaburi 4), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Hangzhou has a Tuesday final, which allows the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger.
