Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted. ****Commitment players are automatically accepted into the main draw of all ATP Tour 500 events in which they have entered in a proper manner.**

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

The Tuesday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in (Qualifying and Main draw) takes place on **Sunday 22 September from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING CHINA?

Once the invitation letter is received, please complete and submit the application form via the Chinese Visa Application Center and apply for the China "M" Business Visa - appropriate for participation in a professional sports event as an athlete, coach, team physician or other support personnel.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio). All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A3: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, all lists will move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q4: WHAT ARE THE DETAILS OF THE OFF-COURT COACHING TRIAL?

A4: Coaching is allowed at ATP Tour tournaments through the end of 2024 on a trial basis with the following conditions:

- The coach must sit in the tournament's designated coaches' seats on all courts
- Verbal coaching is permitted only when the player is at the same end of the court
- Verbal coaching may consist of a few words and/or short phrases (no conversations are permitted)
- Non-verbal coaching (hand signals) is permitted
- Coaching (verbal and non-verbal) is allowed only if it does not interrupt play or create any hindrance to the opponent
- Coaches may not speak to their player, when the player leaves the court for any reason
- Penalties and fines to apply for abuse or misuse of the coaching conditions

Q5: HOW DOES THE 2024 ATP 500 BONUS POOL WORK?

A5: Total compensation of \$1,340,000 will be distributed to the Top 5 players with the most PIF ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour 500* category in 2024. Players must be in good standing and meet platinum benefits eligibility and commitment requirements.

The distribution will be as follows:

1. Rank 1: \$615,000
2. Rank 2: \$310,000
3. Rank 3: \$205,000
4. Rank 4: \$130,000
5. Rank 5: \$80,000

*For the avoidance of doubt, points from the Monte Carlo Masters 1000 tournament will not be included in the ATP Tour 500 bonus pool point calculation.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN BEIJING (WEDNESDAY FINALS) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT

- ATP Tour still competing deadline (**week of Sept.30th**): Shanghai

- **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into the Shanghai qualifying the week of **Sept.30th** and are still competing in Beijing on **Monday Sept.30th at the start of Shanghai Q**, will be automatically withdrawn from Shanghai Q.

- Challenger Tour still competing deadline (**week of Sept.30th**): Alicante/Mouilleron-le-captif/Braga/Buenos Aires/Tiburon

- **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger Main Draw the week of **Sept.30th** and are still competing in Beijing on **Saturday Sept.28 by 9:00pm local time (Challenger)**, will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.

- **Doubles:** Player/Team competing in Beijing who is directly accepted into a Challenger doubles Main draw the week of **Sept.30th** and is **still competing at the time of the on-site sign-in (Sunday 29 September, 12 noon Challenger local time)**, will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger. Beijing has a Wednesday final, which **does NOT allow** the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger.
