SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 9 December 2024 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 16 December 2024 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Friday 3 January 2025 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Gerry Armstrong, T. +44 7974 688910** (number to be used for sign-in only), email (Gwa@ATPTour.com) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

Monday 23 December 2024 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The Main Draw doubles list will have an entirely advanced protocol of entry. The online on-site doubles entries will still be conducted on **Friday 3 January 2025 from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST (Florida, USA time)** through ATP PlayerZone but only to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the respective tournament withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING AUCKLAND?

A1: Players and other attendees (PST Members, ATP Staff/Officials, Vendors etc) from certain countries can travel to New Zealand without a visa if they obtain an NZeTA (New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority).

The Visa Waiver program covers many countries. The list of those countries not covered can be found [HERE](#).

Individuals **MUST** apply for the NZeTA before travel. To apply for an NZeTA, please click [HERE](#). Allow up to 72 hours for processing.

For those individuals from non-visa waiver countries, you must apply for a [Sports Events Visitor Visa](#) before travelling to New Zealand. **Processing times are longer than expected. Allow up to five (5) weeks for the visa to be issued.** The official New Zealand Immigration website will require you to create an online account. Please follow the instructions noted below once you click on 'apply for a visa':

- Apply for Temporary Class Visa
- Outside New Zealand: Yes
- Type of Visa: Visitor
- Citizen of Waiver Country: No
- Purpose of Visit: Event
- Why Visiting New Zealand: As a Participant in a Sports Event
- **PST Members and ATP Staff/Officials to select 'to attend a sport, music or other event'.

Players are recommended to contact their own country's authorities to check any other individual visa requirements to visit New Zealand.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with the tournament invitation letter, ATP letter of support and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member.

All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A3: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, lists will be dropped for withdrawals and move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q4: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?**A4: Late Entries**

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.
