SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 25 August 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted. **Commitment players are automatically accepted into the main draw of all ATP Tour 500 events in which they have entered in a proper manner.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 1 September 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Sunday 21 September from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by phone via text message to the Supervisor, **Cedric Mourier, T. +33 623 20 30 12** (number to be used for sign-in only) or by email Cedric.Mourier@ATPTour.com. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

Monday 8 September 2025 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Sunday 21 September from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone, to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Sunday 21 September through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Doubles Qualifying: Starting Monday 22 September through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Sunday 21 September. Minimum of 6 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Monday 22 September. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. Sharing rooms is not encouraged.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles 500 Lucky Loser: The top lucky loser team to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation: Airport pickup is provided from Haneda International Airport (NHD) and Narita International Airport (NRT). Transportation requests are to be made in advance. Players must make reservations 48 hours prior to arrival.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING JAPAN?

A1: All International players must obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to apply for a working visa (Entertainment Visa) to enter Japan.

It is mandatory to obtain the "Certificate of Eligibility" before applying for the working visa.

If you travelled to Tokyo last year:

- Check if the passport information is still the same as per your last entry. If so, no need to send any materials. Contact Chiho Kobayashi kobayashi@jta-tennis.or.jp and confirm that you will apply for the COE with the same passport.

If you did not travel to Japan last year or your passport is new:

- Complete and submit the COE application form and upload a scanned passport copy and headshot.

Click [HERE](#) to complete and submit the Certificate of Eligibility Application form. **Deadline: Monday 28 July**

PST Members who are from former Soviet Union, Middle East, Cuba, China and certain South American countries, must also obtain the Entertainment Visa and apply for the COE.

Upon receipt of your materials, the tournament will apply for your Certificate of Eligibility to the Ministry of Justice in Japan. Once the application is approved, you will be emailed the Certificate of Eligibility and other necessary documents to your attention. You will need to book an appointment at a Japanese Consulate or Embassy to apply for your working visa. As it may take 6-8 weeks until the Certificate of Eligibility is issued, please forward necessary items well in advance so that you have enough time to visit the Japanese Embassy or Consulate.

You cannot apply for your working visa in China unless you are a Chinese National or reside there.

The JTA has no control over the Japanese Government processing times and only provide reasonable estimates of the processing times. No guarantee any application submitted after the final deadline can be issued in time for the event. The tournament will make best efforts to help all applicants in accordance with the rules. There is no issue if an individual files a visa application and subsequently decides not to travel to Japan.

For non-players (PST Members, ATP staff) who are from the countries stated on the list provided in the link below, these individuals can enter as tourists.

Any PST Members/ATP staff who are from the countries not on the list, they will need to obtain the short-stay visa, which can only be applied for in their home countries. If they cannot apply for the short-stay visa in their countries, they will have to obtain the COE to apply for the Entertainment Visa.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a support letter from ATP and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio).

All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN TOKYO (TUESDAY FINALS) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT:

- **ATP Tour still competing deadline (week of Sep. 29th): Shanghai**
 - **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into the Shanghai qualifying the week of **Sept. 29th** and are still competing in Tokyo on **Monday Sept. 29th** will be automatically withdrawn from Shanghai Q.
- **Challenger Tour still competing deadline (week of Sept. 29th): *Villena/Antofagasta/Braga/Mouilleron-le-captif/Tiburón**
 - **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger Main Draw (**Villena, Antofagasta, Braga, Tiburón**) the week of **Sept. 29th** and are still competing in Tokyo on **Saturday Sept. 27 by 9pm local time (Challenger)**, will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.
 - **The only exception will be Mouilleron-le-Captif (IH).** Players who are directly accepted into Mouilleron-le-Captif Main Draw will be allowed to compete that week. If they withdraw after **Saturday Sept. 27th** by 9pm local time (Challenger), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Tokyo has a Tuesday final, which allows players to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger (Indoor hard events can schedule first rounds on Wednesday).
 - **Doubles:** Player/Team competing in Tokyo who is directly accepted into a Challenger doubles Main draw the week of **Sept. 29th** or sign-in on-site via the supervisor (**Sunday Sept. 28th**, 12 noon local time), **can compete that week**. If he/they withdraw after the on-site sign-in deadline (Sunday), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Tokyo has a Tuesday final, which allows the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger.

HOW DOES THE 2025 ATP 500 BONUS POOL WORK?

Total compensation of \$3,000,000 will be distributed to the Top 6 players with the most PIF ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour 500 category in 2025.

Players must be in good standing and meet platinum benefits eligibility and commitment requirements.

The distribution will be as follows:

- Rank 1: \$1,000,000
- Rank 2: \$500,000
- Rank 3: \$250,000
- Rank 4: \$200,000
- Rank 5: \$100,000
- Rank 6: \$50,000

The remaining 30% of the ATP 500 Bonus Pool will be distributed based on a value per point system using PIF ranking points earned across the ATP Tour 500 events in 2025.
