SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 13 January 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. **Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.**

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 20 January 2023 at 12:pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday 07 February from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor **Rafael Schneider, T. +55 51 981 974 110** (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 27 January 2025 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on Friday 07 February from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Friday 7 February through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.
Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.
Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 8 February. Minimum of 5 nights
Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 8 February. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. (NB. Sharing rooms is strongly discouraged).
Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation: Airport transportation available from Aeropuerto Ministro Pistarini (EZE) and Aeroparque Jorge Newbery (AEP) beginning Thursday 6 February between 7:00 am and 10:00 pm.

Players arriving at Ministro Pistarini Ezeiza Airport [EZE], must announce themselves at the ON BAIREs stand, located inside the airport on the left side after baggage claim and pass to commercial area.

Arrivals at Jorge Newbery Aeroparque [AEP], will be contacted by the driver to pick you up when you finish immigrations.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE THE LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A3: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, lists will be dropped for withdrawals and move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q4: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

Late Entries

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list. To request a Late Entry, E-mail: Cecilia.Ghe@ATPTour.com specifying which tournament(s) you would like to enter.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
