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SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 15 September at **12:00 EDT** (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10:00 (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Wednesday, 24 September at **12:00 EST** (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Saturday, 11 October from 16:00 - 18:00 local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Sunday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Sunday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor; **Carlos Sanches**; +43 6649 200 775 (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Thursday, 2 October at **12:00 EST** (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday, 10 October from 00:01 - 15:00 EST (Florida, USA time)** on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Saturday, 11 October through the night of the player’s last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday, 11 October. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday, 11 October. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player.

Lucky Loser: The number one lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from TennisUNO.

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q2: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A2:

Late Entries

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list. Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the PIF ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying.

Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
