MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 18 August 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Monday 15 September 2025 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Tuesday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Tuesday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 12 September** from **12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Singles Qualifying: Starting Monday 15 September through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Wednesday 17 September. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. Sharing rooms is not encouraged.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING CHINA?

- A1: **All players and PST members require a visa to enter China, with some exceptions noted below. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for visa processing and check for any updates or changes to policies before traveling:**
1. Belarus, Serbian, Kazakhstan, Georgia, Thailand, Uzbekistan and Singapore ordinary passport holders can stay for 30 days visa-free.
 2. **Until December 31, 2025**, ordinary passport holders from the below countries can be exempted from a Visa to enter China and stay for no more than 30 days for business, tourism, family visit, and transit purposes.
Brunei, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Holland, Malaysia, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, New Zealand, Australia, Poland, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, Korea, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Malta, Estonia, Latvia, Japan, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Peru and Uruguay.

Once the invitation letter is received, please complete and submit the application form via the Chinese Visa Application Center and apply for the China "M" Business Visa - appropriate for participation in a professional sports event as an athlete, coach, team physician or other support personnel.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

- A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio).

Players may be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A3: **Late Entries.** There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN CHENGDU (TUESDAY FINAL) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT:

- ATP Tour still competing deadline (**week of 22 September**): Beijing/Tokyo

- **Singles players directedly accepted into Tokyo Q:** Players still competing in Chengdu on **Monday 22 September** will be withdrawn automatically from Tokyo Q Singles.

- **Singles players directedly accepted into Beijing Q:** Players still competing in Chengdu on **Tuesday 23 September** will be withdrawn automatically from Beijing Q Singles.

- **Doubles players still competing** in Chengdu on **Tuesday 23 September** will be withdrawn automatically from Beijing/Tokyo Q Doubles.

- Challenger Tour still competing deadline (**week of 22 September**): Orleans/Jingshan/Lisbon/Buenos Aires/Las Vegas, NV

- **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger Main Draw (**Lisbon, Buenos Aires and Las Vegas**) the week of 22 September and are still competing in Chengdu on **Saturday 20 September** by 9:00pm local time (Challenger), will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.

- **Exceptions: Jingshan (TUES Start) and Orleans (IH).** Players directly accepted into Jingshan and Orleans main draw will be allowed to compete that week. If players accepted in Orleans withdraw after Saturday 20 September by 9:00pm local time (challenger), or if players accepted in Jingshan withdraw after Sunday 21 September by 9:00pm local time (challenger), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Chengdu has a Tuesday final, which allows players to finish the tournament and still make it to the two challengers. Jingshan has a Tuesday start, with first rounds Tues/Wed and Orleans is an Indoor hard event with first rounds Mon-Wed.

- **Doubles:** Player/Team directly accepted into a Challenger doubles main draw the week of 22 September or sign-in on-site via the Supervisor on Sunday 21 September 12 noon local time (**Orleans, Lisbon, Buenos Aires and Las Vegas, NV**), or Monday 22 September 12 noon local time (**Jingshan**), can compete that week. If they withdraw after the on-site sign-in deadline Sunday (**Orleans, Lisbon, Buenos Aires, and Las Vegas, NV**) and Monday (**Jingshan**), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Chengdu has a Tuesday final, which allows the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger.
