Failure to make a reservation by the relevant deadline shall result in that player's automatic forfeiture of hotel accommodations for the tournament week. Failure to CANCEL or CHANGE reservation (i.e. if arriving later than Complimentary Accommodation Start Date) by the relevant deadline shall result in that player's forfeiture of hotel accommodations for nights reserved but not used. In addition, the tournament shall have the right to charge the player at the official tournament hotel's published rate for each night he did not use the room. A player still competing in either singles or doubles in the prior week's tournament must keep the tournament informed if his reservation(s) may change and confirm the final arrival date with the tournament when his travel plans are finalized.
