SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 23 March at 12:00 EST (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from **Saturday, 18 April** at 14:00 local time. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw / Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Saturday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday, 30 March at 12:00 EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Sunday, 19 April from 14:00 – 16:00 local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor; **Hans-Juergen Ochs**; +49 1776 452220 (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor. **The ranking used for Qualifying seeding will be applied to all Qualifying Alternate sign-ins to ensure consistency across the process.**

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE

Singles Main Draw & Qualifying withdrawal deadline is on **Sunday, 19 April** at 2:00 pm local time. Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday, 6 April at 12:00 EST (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Thursday, 23 April from 00:01 – 15:00 EST (Florida, USA time)** on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

NEW WITHDRAWAL / RE-PAIR DEADLINE

Doubles withdrawal / re-pair deadline is on **Thursday, 23 April at 4:00 pm local time.**

DOUBLES DRAW

The top 13 teams from the final 2025 ATP Doubles Team Rankings shall receive automatic Direct Acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events in the 2026 season (if not included as a Direct Acceptance on their own merit). To qualify for automatic acceptance a team must have competed as a team in 11 ATP Tour or Grand Slam events during the 2025 season. A player can only be eligible on one team. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events a team must have competed together as a team in each week of the 2026 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Thursday, 23 April. Minimum of 5 nights.

Lucky Loser: The top four lucky losers to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top two doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1 WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from TennisUNO.

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player’s responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

ATP MASTERS 1000 & NITTO ATP FINALS – 2026 FIXED BONUS POOL

The 2026 ATP Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals Fixed Bonus Pool is set at **USD \$21,537,813**.

The bonus pool is distributed among the **top 30 players** in the final standings, determined by total PIF ATP Ranking points earned across all 2026 ATP Masters 1000 events and the 2026 Nitto ATP Finals.

Bonus Pool Structure

The bonus pool is comprised of two components:

- **70% Fixed Bonus** – Distributed by final position in the bonus pool standings.
- **30% Variable Bonus** – Distributed proportionally based on total ranking points earned at these events. Each ranking point is assigned a dollar value.

Participation

The bonus pool is dependent on player participation. To receive **100% of the eligible bonus amount**, a player must compete in each ATP Masters 1000 event (except Monte Carlo) and in the Nitto ATP Finals in which such player is a main draw direct acceptance.

Any event in which a player is not a main draw direct acceptance shall not be considered a missed event for purposes of bonus pool eligibility.

Promotional Activity Recoupment

A player who is unable to compete in one or more of the applicable events may recoup a portion of any unearned bonus by completing approved on-site promotional activities.

Please note that a player may not recoup more than USD \$200,000 through on-site promotional activities.

Players under the old commitment structure retain any exemptions accumulated through the 2022 season. No additional exemptions may be accumulated after 2022.
