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RESERVATIONS & COMPLIMENTARY ACCOMMODATION

IMPORTANT: All players must reserve their rooms via UNO by the deadlines below. This requirement includes all players accepted into the Main and Qualifying Draws and all nights, including complimentary accommodation nights.

Player accepted into both Singles and Doubles events must comply with the deadline that occurs earlier.

Failure to make a reservation by the relevant deadline shall result in that player's automatic forfeiture of hotel accommodations for the tournament week.

Failure to CANCEL or CHANGE reservation (i.e. if arriving later than Complimentary Accommodation Start Date) by the relevant deadline shall result in that player's forfeiture of hotel accommodations for nights reserved but not used. In addition, the tournament shall have the right to charge the player at the official tournament hotel's published rate for each night he did not use the room.

A player still competing in either singles or doubles in the prior week's tournament must keep the tournament informed if his reservation(s) may change and confirm the final arrival date with the tournament when his travel plans are finalized.

ACCREDITATIONS

All credential requests must be made via [UNO](#) **by Monday 13 April 2026 (this applies to alternate players as well who might enter the tournament last minute.)**

TRAVEL HEALTH ADVISORY

Yellow fever vaccinations is mandatory to enter the Republic of the Congo. DTP, Hepatitis A and Measles vaccinations are recommended. Please check with your physician to ensure all your vaccinations are up to date.

Players are also responsible for checking with the Consular Section of the country of transit and/or destination if any **COVID-19 restrictions** are enforced before travelling.

VISA

PLEASE NOTE: Border restrictions may apply.

Before entering this event, all players should check with their local Consular Service of Congo to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorizations are required.

The Congolese Ministry of the Interior will be issuing on-arrival visa support letters to players and their support team members. The following three (3) documents are to be downloaded from Tennis UNO after requesting the credentials (for both the player and his PST) and letters must be PRINTED (both English and French versions):

1. An on-arrival visa support letter (in French only) from the Congolese Ministry of the Interior
2. A list of players, support team members, and officials who participate in the Brazzaville Challenger 50
3. A personalized support invitation letter (in English and French) from the Congolese Tennis Federation with each participant's name (player and PSTs), as written in their passport, and their passport number

No entry will be permitted without a printed copy of all these above-mentioned documents. The printed copy of these documents is to be shown to check-in staff at the airport (if requested) and to the immigration officer on arrival at Maya-Maya Brazzaville International Airport for the delivery of the VISA upon arrival. In addition, the immigration officers will be issued a list of tournament participants. Please note that screenshots or electronic copies of the letters will **not** be accepted.

It is important that each player uploads their and their PST's most up-to-date passport information (including a copy of their passport's picture page) on their and their PSTs' Tennis Uno profiles. Once a player/support team member updates their information, please apply for your accreditation and hotel accommodations for the Brazzaville Challenger. This will ensure that a request is logged, and the list is updated.

Time is of the essence and last-minute requests will be extremely difficult to handle, so we ask everyone for their full cooperation to ensure tournament staff can handle these requests without delay.

This applies to alternate players as well who might enter the tournament last minute.
