Meat contamination warning:

Due to ongoing concerns over contaminated food in certain parts of the world, the Tennis Anti-Doping Programme (TADP) continues to emphasize the need for players to exercise extreme caution with regards to eating meat (Clenbuterol contamination) in China, Mexico, and Guatemala.

Players are also responsible for checking with the Consular Section of the country of transit and/or destination if any **COVID-19 restrictions** are enforced before travelling.

VISA

PLEASE NOTE: Border restrictions may apply.

Before entering this event, all players should check with their local Consular Service of China to confirm if they will be permitted to enter the country and if any special authorizations are required.

IMPORTANT:

Players and all PST Members must apply for the China "M" Business Visa, appropriate for participation in a professional sports event as an athlete, coach, team physician or other support personnel, with some exceptions noted below. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for visa processing and check for any updates or changes to policies before traveling:

1. Belarus, Serbian, Kazakhstan, Georgia, Thailand, Uzbekistan and Singapore ordinary passport holders can stay for 30 days visa-free.
2. Until December 31, 2026, ordinary passport holders from the below countries can be exempted from a Visa to enter China and stay for no more than 30 days for business, tourism, family visit, and transit purposes.

Brunei, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Holland, Malaysia, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, New Zealand, Australia, Poland, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, Korea, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Malta, Estonia, Latvia, Japan, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Peru and Uruguay.

You will need to provide a) full name, b) nationality, c) passport number, d) copy of your passport photo page, e) dates of entry and exit to and from China and f) indicate which Embassy/Consulate you will apply for the China visa, which Challenger tournaments you intend to play and your expected arrival/departure date. If you have any special requirements (such as if you need business licence etc), please included this in the email.

Once the invitation letter(s) have been received (within 5-7 days) for each tournament you intend to play in China, you will need to complete the online visa application form and book an appointment via a Chinese Visa Application Centre. It is the responsibility of each individual to obtain a visa.
