SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW
Monday 16 February 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from **Saturday 15 March Commitment Deadline at 2:00pm local time**. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Saturday commitment deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES
Monday 23 February 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN
Sunday 15 March from 2:00pm - 4:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Monday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Roland Herfel T: +49 173 2044077** (number to be used for sign-in only), email (**roland.herfel@atptour.com**) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: Singles Qualifying, Singles Main Draw and Doubles Main Draw withdrawal deadline is on **Sunday 15 March at 2:00pm local time**. Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINE
Monday 2 March 2026 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Thursday 19 March from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

To qualify for automatic acceptance a team must have competed as a team in 11 ATP Tour or Grand Slam events during the 2025 season. To qualify for automatic acceptance into the first 5 Masters 1000 events a team must have competed together as a team in each week of the 2026 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

IMPORTANT: Please note that any additional nights booked before hospitality begins or ends will be charged at published Hotel Guest Rate listed above.

BREAKFAST: Players staying at EPIC or JW Marriott Marquis will receive a minimum meal allowance of 10 days (\$400) for Main Draw Singles (MDS), and 5 days (\$200) for Qualifying and Main Draw Doubles (MDD). If a player continues competing beyond the initial 10 or 5 days, additional daily credits will be added accordingly. The credit will be applied directly to each player’s room account and is non-transferable. Only players staying at one of the official Miami Open hotels listed above are eligible to receive this credit.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Saturday 14 March for a minimum of 5 nights.
Lucky Loser: The top four (4) lucky losers to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.
Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 14 March. Minimum of 10 nights.
Doubles Main Draw: Starting Wednesday 18 March. Minimum of 5 nights.
Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top two (2) doubles alternate teams shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.
MEALS: Meal money will be allocated based on Hotel Hospitality dates – \$110 per player + \$55 for 2 designated PST.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport pick up is provided beginning Thursday March 12 from/to Miami International Airport ONLY for all players between 7am and 10pm with 24 hours advance notice. Coaches and player guests (PST) will only be picked up if accompanied by their player. Drop off will be at any of the Tournament hotels (and within 1 mile radius of the tournament hotel). Please book your arrival/pick-up on Tennis UNO.

Shuttle Transportation is available between tournament hotels and the tournament site beginning at 8am from Thursday March 12. All Main Draw Players are eligible to receive private car transfers between the site and official tournament hotels (and within 1 mile radius of the tournament hotels or site if staying at non-tournament locations). Q1: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q2: WHERE CAN TAX/PRIZE MONEY QUERIES BE DIRECTED?

Q3: HOW DOES THE COMPLIMENTARY PLAYER AND COACH LAUNDRY WORK IN MIAMI?

A3: Complimentary player and coach laundry service begins Thursday 12 March. Laundry must be dropped off on-site (located in the hallway near the Player Café) by 6:00pm and will be ready for pick-up by 9:00am the following morning. Up to eight pounds of laundry is complimentary each day. Any weight over the eight-pound limit will be charged at a rate of \$3.25 per pound, with payment by credit card required at the time of pick-up.

Q4: WHAT ARE THE RULES REGARDING THE NEW COMMITMENT AND BONUS POOL STRUCTURE FOR THE ATP MASTER 1000 & NITTO ATP FINALS?

A4: The 2026 ATP Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals Fixed Bonus Pool is set at **USD \$21,537,813**.

The bonus pool is distributed among the **top 30 players** in the final standings, determined by total PIF ATP Ranking points earned across all 2026 ATP Masters 1000 events and the 2026 Nitto ATP Finals.

Bonus Pool Structure

The bonus pool is comprised of two components:

- **70% Fixed Bonus** – Distributed by final position in the bonus pool standings.
- **30% Variable Bonus** – Distributed proportionally based on total ranking points earned at these events. Each ranking point is assigned a dollar value.

Participation

The bonus pool is dependent on player participation. To receive **100% of the eligible bonus amount**, a player must compete in each ATP Masters 1000 event (except Monte Carlo) and in the Nitto ATP Finals in which such player is a main draw direct acceptance. Any event in which a player is not a main draw direct acceptance shall not be considered a missed event for purposes of bonus pool eligibility.

Promotional Activity Recoupment

A player who is unable to compete in one or more of the applicable events may recoup a portion of any unearned bonus by completing approved on-site promotional activities.

Please note that a player may not recoup more than USD \$200,000 through on-site promotional activities.

Q5: WHAT HAPPENS IF I STAY IN A TOURNAMENT HOTEL BEFORE OR AFTER MY HOSPITALITY DATES ARE EFFECTIVE?

A5: Players will pay the hotel directly for any nights before or after hospitality dates at the published rate of each property. For example, the JW Marriott Marquis nights outside of hospitality would be \$449 + taxes for each night.
