SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES
Monday 6 July 2026 at 12:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES
Monday 13 July 2026 at 12:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN
Friday 31 July 2026 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor, **Cedric Mourier, T. +33 623 20 30 12** (number to be used for sign-in only), email (Cedric.Mourier@ATPTour.com) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE
Singles Qualifying and Singles Main Draw withdrawal deadline is on **Friday 31 July at 10:00am local time.** Any withdrawals occurring after this time will be considered late withdrawals.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 20 July 2026 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Monday 3 August from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT (Florida, USA time)** on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

DOUBLES DRAW

*For each of the remaining four (4) Masters 1000 events, the top 13 teams in the Team Race at the advanced entry deadline for that event, shall receive automatic Direct Acceptance into that Masters 1000 event (if not included as a Direct Acceptance on their own merit). A player can only be eligible on one team.

To qualify for automatic acceptance into the final 4 Masters 1000 events, a team must compete together as a team in each week of the 2025 season where both players were playing doubles in that week. The exception would be when they were both involved in the singles of different events.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE VISA REQUIREMENT FOR CANADA?

A1: Please check the official Government of Canada website [HERE](#) to find out if you require a VISA or eTA to enter the country.

While the Canadian Government has been working hard to deal with the backlog of VISA applicants, we strongly advise anyone who may consider the Canadian events in their plans to begin this process as soon as possible.

For Visa letters, please email Francis Milloy (fmilloy@tenniscanada.com) with the following information:

- Full name
- Country of origin
- Passport number
- Status (player, coach, etc.)

IMPORTANT: Tag your visa application (Form IMM 5257) with the special event code. In the ‘Details of Visit to Canada’ section, select: ‘Other.’ For question “1a) Purpose of my visit,” enter the special event code 26OBQN into the free text box in “1b) Other”.

Once submitted, please ensure you send the visa application number for everyone to fmilloy@tenniscanada.com.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q3: WHAT OTHER INFORMATION SHOULD PLAYERS BE AWARE OF REGARDING PRIZE MONEY AND TAXES IN CANADA?

A3: If the athlete’s tax residency is not in Canada, according to paragraph 153(1)(g) of the Canadian Income Tax Act and Regulation 105, Tennis Canada is required to withhold 15% of the payment (and an additional 9% if service is rendered in Quebec) on behalf of the CRA, unless an approved waiver is present. Tennis Canada will remit the deductions to the CRA and issue a T4A-NR (or RL-1 in Quebec) to each athlete receiving prize money, by the end of February of the year following the payment of the prize money.

Tax liability in Canada is the responsibility of each player. Your options are laid out on the “ TAX FORM FOR ATHLETES ” form, available on Tennis UNO or at the Prize Money office.

Q4: WHAT ARE THE CURRENT RULES REGARDING COMMITMENT AND BONUS POOL STRUCTURE FOR THE ATP MASTER 1000 & NITTO ATP FINALS?

A4: In The ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals 2025 Bonus Pool is currently set at USD \$21,012,500. The standings are based on total PIF ATP Ranking points earned across the ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals events in 2025. The ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals Bonus Pool is distributed among the top 30 players in the standings (conditions of eligibility apply).
COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: Top 30 players will be eligible for the bonus pool in 2025 based on total PIF rankings points earned at the ATP Tour Masters 1000 and Nitto ATP Finals events in 2025.

To receive 100% of the bonus pool a player must play all mandatory ATP Tour Masters 1000 events and the Nitto ATP Finals in which such player is a main draw direct acceptance.

A player’s Bonus total will be reduced by 25% for every missed Masters 1000 event. Players may fulfil on-site promotional requirements to recover 12.5% of the 25% reduction per tournament. This may be done a maximum of two times per year, and players may recover a maximum of 200,000 USD. See Bonus’ reductions below based on the number of ATP Masters 1000s missed:

OLD COMMITMENT STRUCTURE: Under the old structure, players will keep the exemptions they accumulated through 2022. Players will not accumulate further exemptions going forward. If a player selected the New Commitment Structure, any existing exemption(s) will be removed, and the player moves into the New Commitment Structure.

IMPORTANT: This choice is for bonus compensation only. No new exemptions will be granted moving forward for those electing to keep commitment exemptions earned prior to December 31, 2022. Starting in 2023, each player can only replace Masters 1000 singles main draw results with a better score from an ATP Tour 500 or ATP Tour 250 event, when the replacing score is achieved after the Masters 1000 score that is being replaced. No players will be able to replace zero (0) point ranking penalties for missing Masters 1000 tournaments for any reason.
