SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 12 January 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday 6 Friday from 4:00pm - 6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Zsolt Beda, T. +1 409 256 9451** (number to be used for sign-in only), email (Zsolt.Beda@ATPTour.com) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 26 January 2026 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 6 February from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Singles Qualifying: Starting Friday 6 February through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Friday 6 February . Minimum of 6 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 7 February. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. (Sharing rooms is not encouraged.)

Doubles Qualifying: Starting Friday 6 February through the night of the player's last match.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles 500 Lucky Loser: The top lucky loser team to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS ENTERING THE UNITED STATES?

A1: Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and / or USA) for what type of visa is required to enter the USA.

It is the player's responsibility to check any additional and individual travel requirements.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q3: PST ACCREDITATION AND GUESTS

A3: The Dallas Open would like to make your stay as comfortable as possible. For that reason, the tournament have set up the following guidelines regarding PST passes and guest passes. Every player still active in the main draw at the Dallas Open receives:

- 3 passes (player + 2 accompanying persons (PSTs) as per ATP rules) - These give access to all players' facilities, such as dressing rooms (limited access), players' restaurant & lounge, but also to the areas around the stadium - Food and drinks in the players' restaurant & lounge are included in these passes, without limitation.

Should you want to welcome additional staff, family or guests in the players facilities, it is possible to request a maximum of two (2) additional PST passes per player per day still active in the main draw. This can be arranged through the credential office, located at the Omni Hotel or requested in advance at credentials@dallasopen.com.

Additional PSTs will have access to the Player Family and Guest lounge. Access to Player Dining is not included.

Q4: HOW DO PLAYERS ACCESS COWBOYS FIT GYM?

A4: In order to access Cowboys Fit, players and their support team will need to show their Nexo Dallas Open Accreditation at the front desk.

*Please note that Cowboys Fit has a policy that does not allow for outside trainers. If a player coach, physio or physical trainer is in the gym with a player, they must work out set for set with the player. If this policy is not adhered to, Cowboys Fit reserves the right to no longer allow players to use their facility. The tournament appreciates your adherence to this policy.
