MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 24 August 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Tuesday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Tuesday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 18 September** from **12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Singles Qualifying: Starting Monday 21 September through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Monday 21 September. Minimum of 5 nights.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING CHINA?

A1: **All players and PST members require a visa to enter China, with some exceptions noted below. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for visa processing and check for any updates or changes to policies before traveling:**

1. Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, The Bahamas, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Dominica, Fiji, Grenada, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Qatar, Malaysia, Mauritius, Samoa, Serbia, Seychelles, San Marino, Singapore, Surinam, Solomon Islands, Thailand, Tonga, the United Arab Emirates, Uzbekistan ordinary passport holders can stay for **30 days visa-free** for the purposes of tourism, business, or sports competitions.

2. **Until December 31, 2026**, ordinary passport holders from the below countries can be exempted from a Visa to enter China and **stay for no more than 30 days** for the purposes of tourism, business, or sports competitions.

Brunei, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, New Zealand, Australia, Poland, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, the Republic of Korea, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Malta, Estonia, Latvia, Japan, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Peru, Uruguay, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Kuwait, Bahrain, Russia, Sweden, Canada and UK.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio).

All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#). It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A3: **Late Entries**

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN HANGZHOU (TUESDAY FINAL) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT

- ATP Tour still competing deadline (week of 28 September): Beijing/Tokyo

• **Singles:**

Singles players directedly accepted into Tokyo Q and Beijing Q: Players still competing in Hangzhou on Monday, Sept. 28th will be withdrawn automatically from Tokyo Q and Beijing Q Singles.

• **Doubles:**

Players still competing in Hangzhou on Tuesday, Sept. 29th will be withdrawn automatically from Beijing/Tokyo Q Doubles.

- Challenger Tour still competing deadline (week of 28 September): Jingshan/Columbus/Mouilleron-le-Captif/Porto/Curitiba/Bari

• **Singles:**

Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger Main Draw (**Porto, Curitiba, Bari**) the week of Sept. 28 and are still competing in Hangzhou on Saturday Sept. 26th by 9pm local time (Challenger), will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.

Exceptions: Jingshan (TUES Start), Columbus (IH), and Mouilleron-le-Captif (IH). Players directly accepted into Jingshan, Columbus and Mouilleron-le-Captif main draw will be allowed to compete that week. If players accepted in Columbus and Mouilleron-le-Captif withdraw after Saturday Sept. 26th by 9pm local time (Challenger), or if players accepted in Jingshan withdraw after Sunday Sept. 27st by 9pm local time (Challenger), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Hangzhou has a Tuesday final, which allows players to finish the tournament and still make it to the three Challengers. Jingshan has a Tuesday start, with first rounds Tues/Wed and Columbus & Mouilleron-le-Captif are Indoor events with first rounds Mon-Wed.

• **Doubles:**

Player/Team directly accepted into a Challenger doubles Main draw the week of Sept. 28th or sign-in on-site via the Supervisor Sunday 27th 12 noon local time (**Porto, Columbus, Mouilleron-le-Captif, Curitiba and Bari**) or Monday 28th 12 noon Local time (**Jingshan**), can compete that week. If they withdraw after the on-site sign-in deadline (Porto, Columbus, Mouilleron-le-Captif, Curitiba and Bari) and Monday (Jingshan), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Hangzhou has a Tuesday final, which allows the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challengers.
