SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 19 January 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday 26 January 2026 at 12:pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday 13 February from 4:00pm - 6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Qualifying Supervisor, **Roland Herfel; +49 173 2044077** (number to be used for sign-in only). email (Roland.Herfel@ATPTour.com) or in person. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday 2 February 2026 at 12:00pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 13 February from 12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made.

Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Friday 13 February through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 14 February. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 14 February. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. (Sharing rooms is discouraged.)

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw

TRANSPORTATION

Airport transportation: Starts Wednesday 11 February after 1:00pm, and available from 8:30am – 10:00pm, daily thereafter. If arrival is between 7 - 8:30am, email ccramer@YellowTennisBall.com for details. **Pickup is located OUTSIDE, in front of the airline arrivals door.**

West Palm Beach International (PBI) 30 minutes to courts and 40 minutes to Boca Raton official tournament hotels.

- Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International (FLL) 40 minutes to courts and 30 minutes to Boca Raton official tournament hotels.
- Transportation is **NOT** provided from Miami International airport (MIA). A typical car journey from Miami airport is 1 hour to Boca Raton official hotels and can be longer depending on traffic.
- There is a rail option from Miami airport to the city of Delray Beach (travel time is 1.5 hours). Rail station pick up is available from the Delray Beach rail station.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS ENTERING THE UNITED STATES?

A1: Players should check with their local consular service (the country of transit and / or USA) for what type of visa is required to enter the USA.

It is the player's responsibility to check any additional and individual travel requirements.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from [TennisUNO](https://www.tennisuno.com).

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A3: Late Entries

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the PIF ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized.

A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
