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SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday, 25 May at 12:00 EDT (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10:00 (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw / Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES

Monday, 1 June at 12:00 EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN

Friday, 19 June from 16:00 – 18:00 local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. All sign-ins are to be done by text message to the Supervisor; **Anne Bees**; +1 604 880 9439 (number to be used for sign-in only). The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

DOUBLES ENTRY DEADLINES

Monday, 8 June at 12:00 EST (noon, Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday, 19 June from 00:01 – 15:00 EST (Florida, USA time)** on ATP PlayerZone to populate an Alternate List for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Singles Qualifying: Friday, 19 June through the night of the player’s last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday, 20 June. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday, 20 June. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player.

Lucky Loser: The number one lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1 WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A1: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a tournament letter of invitation, a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (Chubb) which covers Player plus one PST member (either official coach or physio).

All letters can be downloaded from TennisUNO.

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

To request support letters, proof of insurance, or if you need your Digital ID resent to you, players should email Members@Support.ATPTour.com.

Q2 HOW MUCH TAX WILL BE WITHHELD FROM PRIZE MONEY?

A2: Local Tax: Prize money issued by the LTA events is subject to a withholding tax under UK tax Authority. Under the revised 'Reduced Rate Tax Withholding Application' the amount earned by any non-UK resident player before tax is £12,570 from 6th April 2026 to 5th April 2027.

Once a non-UK resident player's earnings exceed this amount, all prize money earned from LTA events will be subject to a 20% withholding tax deduction.

An FEU2 form will be issued, detailing PM earned and tax withheld. Players should retain a copy for their records. A duplicate copy cannot be issued. In most instances the tax deducted can be offset against tax paid in your home country. The LTA will be responsible for paying the tax withheld to the UK tax authority.
