Monday 31 August 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted. ****Commitment players are automatically accepted into the main draw of all ATP Tour 500 events in which they have entered in a proper manner.**

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

The Monday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in (Qualifying and Main draw) takes place on **Sunday 27 September** from **12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles 500 Lucky Loser: The top lucky loser team to sign in the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation: Nearest airport is Beijing Capital International (PEK). Airport pick up available from Wednesday 23 September for players only. If a player is one of the passengers in the car, PST members can utilise pick up service. Beijing Daxing International Airport (PKX) pick up service will be scheduled case by case.

- Beijing Capital Int'l: 25mins from Marriott Marquis hotel, 40mins from site
 - Beijing Daxing Airport: 60mins from Marriott Marquis hotel, and 80 minutes from site
- Beijing Marriott Marquis hotel is 10 minutes from site. Cars and shuttles are available for players between the hotel and venue. PSTs are eligible for shuttle transportation only, unless travelling in a car with a player. Cars available from 7:00am to two hours after the last match. Shuttle services from 8:00am to two hours after the last match, beginning 25 September until 6 October (peak hour every 20 minutes).

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING CHINA?

A1: **All players and PST members require a visa to enter China, with some exceptions noted below. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for visa processing and check for any updates or changes to policies before traveling:**

1. Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, The Bahamas, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Dominica, Fiji, Grenada, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Qatar, Malaysia, Mauritius, Samoa, Serbia, Seychelles, San Marino, Singapore, Surinam, Solomon Islands, Thailand, Tonga, the United Arab Emirates and Uzbekistan ordinary passport holders can stay for **30 days visa-free** for the purposes of tourism, business, or sports competitions.

2. **Until December 31, 2026**, ordinary passport holders from the below countries can be exempted from a Visa to enter China and **stay for no more than 30 days** for the purposes of tourism, business, or sports competitions. **Brunei, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, New Zealand, Australia, Poland, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, the Republic of Korea, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Malta, Estonia, Latvia, Japan, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Peru, Uruguay, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Kuwait, Bahrain, Russia, Sweden, Canada and UK.**

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio). All letters can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

STILL COMPETING DEADLINES: COMPETING IN BEIJING (TUESDAY FINAL) AND ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING WEEK'S EVENT:

- ATP Tour still competing deadline (week of Oct. 5th): Shanghai

- **Singles:** Players who are directly accepted into the Shanghai qualifying the week of Oct. 5th and are still competing in Beijing on Monday Oct. 5th will be automatically withdrawn from Shanghai Q.

- Challenger Tour still competing deadline (week of Oct. 5th): *Villena/Braga/Antofagasta/Palermo/Wuning 3

• Singles:

Players who are directly accepted into a Challenger Main Draw (**Villena, Braga, Antofagasta, Palermo, Wuning 3**) the week of Oct. 5th and are still competing in Beijing ATP 500 on Saturday Oct. 3rd by 9pm local time (Challenger), will be automatically withdrawn from the Challenger.

• Doubles:

Player/Team competing in Beijing ATP 500 who is directly accepted into a Challenger doubles Main draw the week of Oct. 5th or sign-in on-site via the supervisor (Sunday Oct. 4th, 12 noon local time), can compete that week. If he/they withdraw after the on-site sign-in deadline (Sunday), they will be assessed a late withdraw fine. Beijing has a Tuesday final, which allows the player/team to finish the tournament and still make it to the Challenger.

Q3: HOW DOES THE 2026 ATP TOUR 500 FIXED BONUS POOL WORK?

A3: Total compensation of \$3,075,000 will be distributed to the Top 6 players with the most PIF ATP Rankings points earned at the ATP Tour 500 category in 2026.

Players must be in good standing and meet platinum benefits eligibility and commitment requirements.

70% of the Bonus Pool will be distributed as follows:

- Rank 1: \$1,025,000
- Rank 2: \$512,500
- Rank 3: \$256,250
- Rank 4: \$205,000
- Rank 5: \$102,500
- Rank 6: \$51,250

The remaining 30% will be distributed based on a value per point system using PIF ranking points earned across the ATP Tour 500 events in 2026.
