SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES (based on **November 17, 2025 year-end rankings**)
Monday 15 December 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.
Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING SINGLES (based on **November 17, 2025 year-end rankings**)
Monday 22 December 2025 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE
Saturday 10 January 2025 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Sunday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Sunday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 9 January from 12:01am - 3:00pm EDT** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone, to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Saturday 10 January through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 10 January. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 10 January. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. Sharing rooms is not encouraged.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation: Airport pick-up available for all players from 3 January. Nearest airport is Adelaide International (ADL) – located approximately 25 minutes away from the site and tournament hotel. A shuttle service will be used in addition to cars.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) with an ATP letter of support.

Please email Members@Support.ATPTour.com for all travel support documents, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one PST member.

It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE THE NEW LIST MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES?

A3: Once the acceptance lists are finalized, lists will be frozen until Tuesday, 12 Noon, Eastern Time, USA the week before the tournament (except for Masters 1000 MDS lists). At that time, lists will be dropped for withdrawals and move as per normal until the Friday Withdrawal Deadline (10 AM, Eastern Time, USA).

Q4: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?

A4: **Late Entries**

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list.

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the PIF ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
