SINGLES ENTRY DEADLINES

MAIN DRAW SINGLES

Monday 21 September 2026 at 12pm EST (Florida, USA time) through ATP PlayerZone. Players on the Alternate Lists will be considered a Direct Acceptance from Thursday, 10 AM (Eastern Time, USA) before the tournament. Players who move in from the Alternate Lists to the Main Draw/Qualifying that have not withdrawn by the Thursday deadline will have their withdrawal count the same way as players who were directly accepted.

QUALIFYING ALTERNATE SIGN-IN DEADLINE

Friday 16 October 2026 from 4:00pm-6:00pm local time. Qualifying vacancies after the qualifying draw is made shall be filled from the Saturday sign-in, open to any ranked players eligible to compete at the event. The Saturday sign-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of qualifying matches. The player is responsible for having his entry confirmed by the Supervisor.

IMPORTANT: The doubles online on-site alternate sign-in takes place on **Friday 16 October** from **12:01am - 3:00pm EST** (Florida, USA time) on ATP PlayerZone to populate an alternate list for any vacancies occurring after the withdrawal deadline and prior to the doubles draw being made. Teams who did not enter through the online on-site alternate sign-in are eligible to sign the daily alternate sign-in and are placed below those teams on the alternate list who did enter through the online method. To be eligible, those teams must sign-in on the first day of the doubles competition.

HOSPITALITY

Singles Qualifying: Starting Friday 16 October through the night of the player's last Qualifying match.

Singles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 17 October. Minimum of 5 nights.

Doubles Main Draw: Starting Saturday 17 October. Minimum of 2 nights if staying in individual rooms; minimum of 5 nights, if sharing a room with another player. Sharing rooms is not encouraged.

Lucky Loser: The number one (1) lucky loser to sign the Lucky Loser list each day shall receive accommodation through each night he is eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Doubles Alternates: Rooms for the top doubles alternate team shall be available from the night prior to the start of the doubles competition through each night they are eligible to be inserted into the draw.

Q1: WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVELLERS ENTERING KAZAKHSTAN?

A1: Kazakhstan resumed **30-day** visa free regime for the citizens of the following countries: Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Moldova, Serbia, Turkey, UAE, Korea, Tajikistan, Brazil, Argentina, Ecuador, Australia, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Oman, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, United Kingdom, USA, Vatican and Vietnam. The visa-free period for citizens of Hong Kong, Iran, India and China is **14 days**.

Individuals from the above-mentioned countries do not need a visa, however you will still receive a participation letter from the Kazakhstan Tennis Federation to show as supporting documentation on arrival. The letter will be provided once your accreditation request has been submitted via [Tennis UNO](#).

Citizens of all other countries must have a special visa invitation letter issued and signed by the Migration Police of Kazakhstan before applying for the E-Visa. Players and their PST members must submit their information via an online form to receive the special confirmation/visa support letter which they will need to apply for the E-Visa.

****LINK: Once the visa invitation letter is received, please register [HERE](#).** A visa fee of US \$80 will be payable. If the application is completed successfully, you will receive the E-Visa by email within an hour.

Note: All visa recipients **MUST have at least two (2) blank pages in their passport and must travel with the passport they submitted for the visa** otherwise they will be deported. 3x4 photo is required for any visa applications. Passport must be valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa.

Q2: WHICH DOCUMENTS DO PLAYERS AND THEIR TEAM MEMBERS NEED TO TRAVEL WITH? WHO CAN PROVIDE THESE DOCUMENTS?

A2: ATP can provide all players (and their nominated player support team (PST) members) planning to participate with a letter of support from ATP, and proof of travel insurance (AXA) which covers Player plus one (1) PST member (either official coach or physio).

All travel support documents can be downloaded from [Tennis UNO](#).

Players may also be required to travel with appropriate visa documents. It is each player's responsibility to check with the airline which document(s) is required for travel.

Q3: WHAT ARE LATE ENTRIES AND NEXT GEN SPOTS?**A3: Late Entries**

There is now a Late Entry spot at each ATP 250 event (Main Draw Singles). The entry deadline for ATP 250 Late Entry spots is Thursday, 10 AM Eastern Time, USA prior to the Monday of the tournament week. Only players with a ranking better than the original tournament entry list cut are allowed to enter. Should the Late Entry spot not be utilized, the position will go to the next eligible player on the entry list. T

Next Gen Spots

An initiative creating new playing opportunities for players aged 20 & under who break into the Top 250 of the Pepperstone ATP Rankings has been approved. Players who break into the Top 250 and are aged 20 & under will be eligible to use a limited number of opportunities at ATP 250 Main Draws and/or Qualifying. Opportunities are only available during weeks when at least 3x ATP Tour events are taking place. Draw spots will be reserved and will drop to the next highest-ranked player should they not be utilized. A maximum of 1 Next Gen (NG) spot may be awarded in one of the Main Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks. A maximum of 1 NG spot may be awarded in one of the Qualifying Draws of the ATP 250s held during eligible weeks.
